NOVEMBER DEAD LIST 2020 - Dead List envelopes are available at the back of both churches. On a sheet of paper, make a list of all the people for whom you wish to pray during the month of November. Put this list in the envelope, along with your donation. On the <u>front of the envelope</u> write: "<u>For the family and friends</u> <u>of..." (insert just your family name).</u> Envelopes can be handed to Canon Tim or put though the letterbox on the door into the Parish Rooms at St Joseph's.

Our Churches will be open for Private on Sunday St Michael's from 9am to 10am St Joseph's from 11am to 12noon

You may arrive and depart at anytime during the hour Church is open.

Unless you are exempt, please ensure that you have a face-covering/mask with you and put it on before entering church.

If there is a queue outside the church, please maintain good social distancing.

The Stewards will ask you to sanitise your hands on entry and provide your name and a contact number for yourself or the Household you are with. This information will be kept for 21 days to assist with track and trace.

The Stewards will direct you to available seating. Those of the same household or in a social bubble may sit together.

You will be asked to sanitise your hands as you leave.

You must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when inside church or outdoors.

When leaving your seat please ensure that you respect others and maintain social distancing. There will be no Toilet facilities available at either church.

ST JOSEPH'S

Entrance and Exit is by the door at the end of the footbridge next to the school.

Seating is identified by a label with a Letter and Number (e.g. A1). Each Bench where 2 seats are marked can accommodate 2 Individuals from different Households 1 metre apart, or a group of Adults and Children from the same Household. Benches with only 1 seat marked can only be occupied by 1 Individual.

The Benches, or parts of them which are not to be used will have "DO NOT SIT HERE" signs on them.

ST MICHAEL'S

Entrance and Exit is through the main doors at the front.

The benches are separated at 2 metres, but the seating is labelled at 1M.

The Benches, or parts of them which are not to be used will have "DO NOT SIT HERE" signs on them.
