Here are some basic scriptures on salvation:

- **Titus 3:5**, Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- **John 3:16**, For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- James 1:21b-22, receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. 22, But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- 1 Peter 3:21a, baptism doth also now save us.
- Acts 2:38-40, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. 39, For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. 40, And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.
