 emphasizes God's roles as Creator, Father of angels, Father of born-again believers, and Father of the humanity of Jesus Christ. It always refers to the invisi- ble Spirit of God.
 refers to both the humanity of Jesus Christ and the flesh that God became for the purpose of man's sal- vation.
3 emphasizes God's active power in the world and among men and refers to His work of regenerating a believer to a new life through the infilling of the Spirit. It always refers God's ability to anoint, baptize, fill, bless, and indwell human lives.
John 5:43. I am come in my Eather's name, and we receive me not: if another shall come

John 5:43, I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

John 14:26, But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

This explains why the disciples of Jesus obeyed Matthew 28:19 by always baptizing "in the name of Jesus" (see Acts 2:38; 8:16; 10:48; 19:5; 22:16; I Corinthians 1:12-13).
