8, Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. 9, For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

TLB 8, Don't let others spoil your faith and joy with their philosophies, their wrong and shallow answers built on men's thoughts and ideas, instead of on what Christ has said. 9, For in Christ there is all of God in a human body.

- d. _____ - singular - means "almighty."

Notice that "Eloah" is singular and "Elohim" is plural. In the Hebrew language, plurality can mean "more than one," or it can also be used to mean "majesty or rank."

- **Deuteronomy, 6:4** Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD.

- **Isaiah 44:6, 8**, Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God. . . . 8, Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; I know not any.
- **Isaiah 45:21-22**, Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me. 22, Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.
- **Ephesians 4:6**, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.
- **James 2:19**, Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

- **Isaiah 35:4-6**, Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence; he will come and save you. 5, Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. 6, Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.
- **Luke 7:22**, Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.
- **Isaiah 40:3**, The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.
- **Matthew 3:1-3**, In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea, 2, And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. 3, For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.
