## **Additional Terms of this Warranty:**

You must adhere to the terms and conditions of the warranty listed here, if you don't, your claim could be rejected or the warranty terminated. This does not affect your statutory rights

1. Darlington Cars reserves the right to reject a claim where the cause of a defect is due to non-compliance with the manufactures recommended service intervals or the manufactures recommendations for care and maintenance of the vehicle.
2. Your warranty may become invalidated if you continue to drive when a fault is apparent.
3. Reasonable diagnostic charges associate with covered parts will only be accepted with the claim.
4. The quality of the repairs will be the responsibility of Darlington Cars Limited who will repair the vehicle (via a successful claim) back to manufactures standard. The warranty lies with the dealership. Repairs outside the organisation are only permissible and reimbursable with prior agreement from the warranty provider. In this instance, written estimates will be required from the repairer and be directly settled via Darlington Cars Limited. Any ongoing workmanship or related repairs to the settled claim will be the responsibility of the third party/clients chosen repairer and not Darlington Cars Limited
5. Darlington Cars reserves the right to inspect the vehicle and examine damaged parts.
6. No cash alternative or refund is available if you do not wish to receive or wish to cancel this warranty. The warranty or balance of warranty cannot be transferred to another private individual or business.
7. Darlington Cars does not permit the transfer of this warranty to another private owner who buys the car from you.
- 8. This warranty does not cover:**
  - i- Damage or loss that can be claimed under another warranty or insurance.
  - ii- Repair or replacement due to gradual reduction in the operating performance of a covered part, commensurate with its age or mileage. Please refer to \*\*
  - iii- Repair or replacement required due to lack of maintenance, abuse or neglect or as a result of an accident.
  - iv- A vehicle that has been subject to alterations, has had experimental equipment fitted or has been modified in any way above the manufacture's specification.
  - v- A vehicle that is used for courier or private hire purposes.
  - vi- Liability for death, bodily injury or damage to property or any consequential loss or damage whether arising directly or indirectly from an incident affecting a part covered by this warranty.
