Chubbles

We were excited to be pouring an extraordinary beer at the Tap recently. Cloudwater Chubbles was first brewed in 2017 with Veil Brewing Co from Richmond Virginia. It defined modern-era TIPAs, breaking the mould, and remains entirely unchanged since. This powerhouse of a Triple IPA uses all English malt, a ton of flaked oats, and loads of Galaxy, Citra, and El Dorado hops.

It is extremely juicy, full of hop flavour and has a deliciously full-on mouthfeel with a touch of tropical sweetness. We were one of very few venues to have it on cask and needless to say, it didn't hang around for long!
