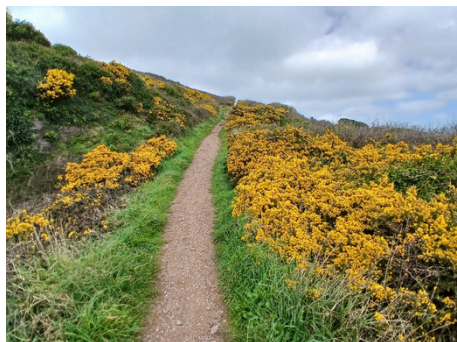


Stan's SW coastal path fundraiser
