Vendor Instructions

Booth Set Up & Tech Load-In: Saturday March 9, is from 2PM to 4PM. All vendors should drive into the load-in area (front parking lot) to set-up. First come, first serve, no assigned areas. Event Producers reserve the right to set-up volunteer and staff booths where needed. You will be give a space for your 10x10 table with 2-4 chairs.

Vendor Check In: A tent or check-in area will be setup for both sponsors and vendors so that "day of" updates and instructions can be provided. No outside food or alcohol to be allowed, or sold on the venue property.

When you reach the check-in tent a volunteer will give you your wristbands and lanyard if needed, which will give you access for the day. Then you will be able to scout and setup your booth. Wristbands must be worn all day to identify you.

Parking is free to the public. Temporary load-in and load out areas will be designated.

Cleaning-Up
