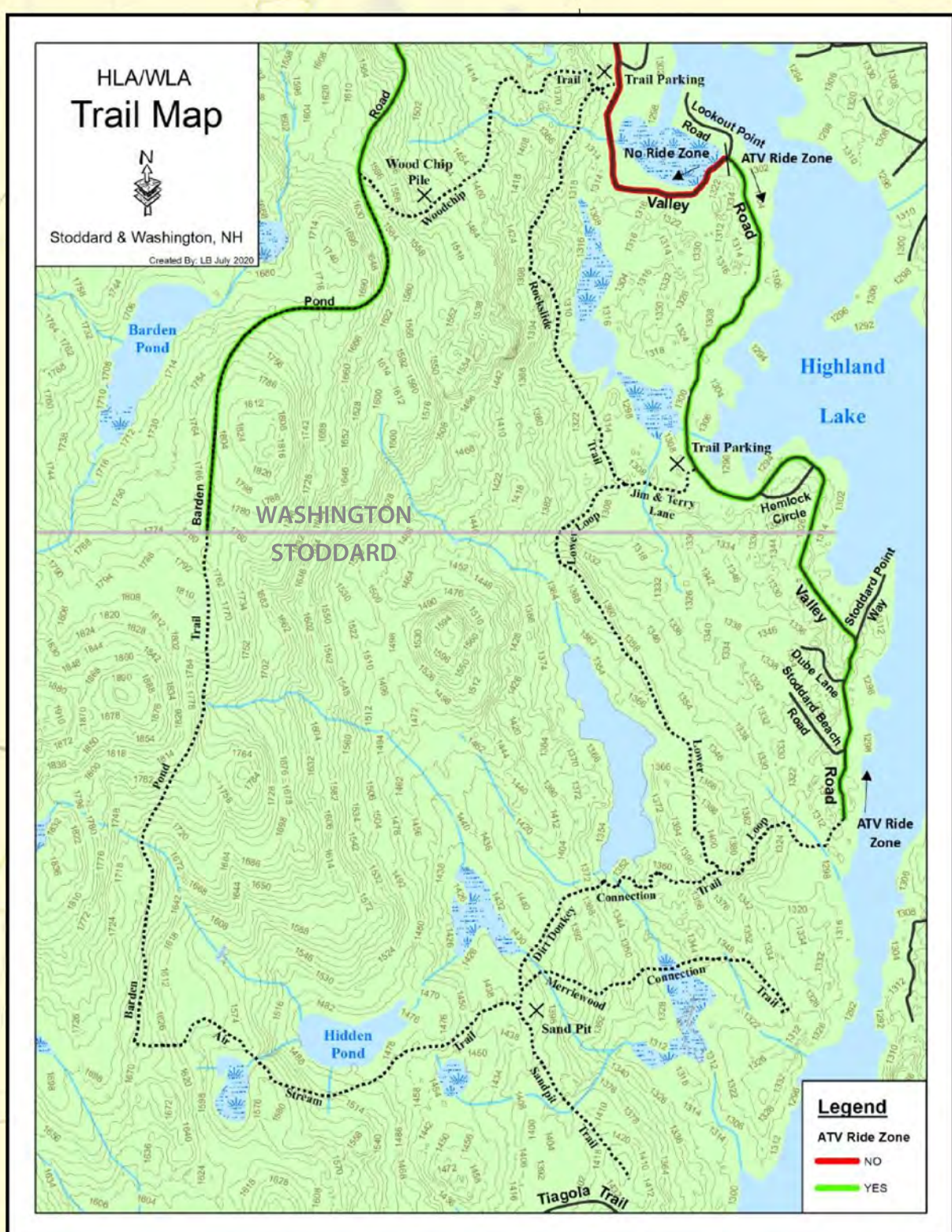
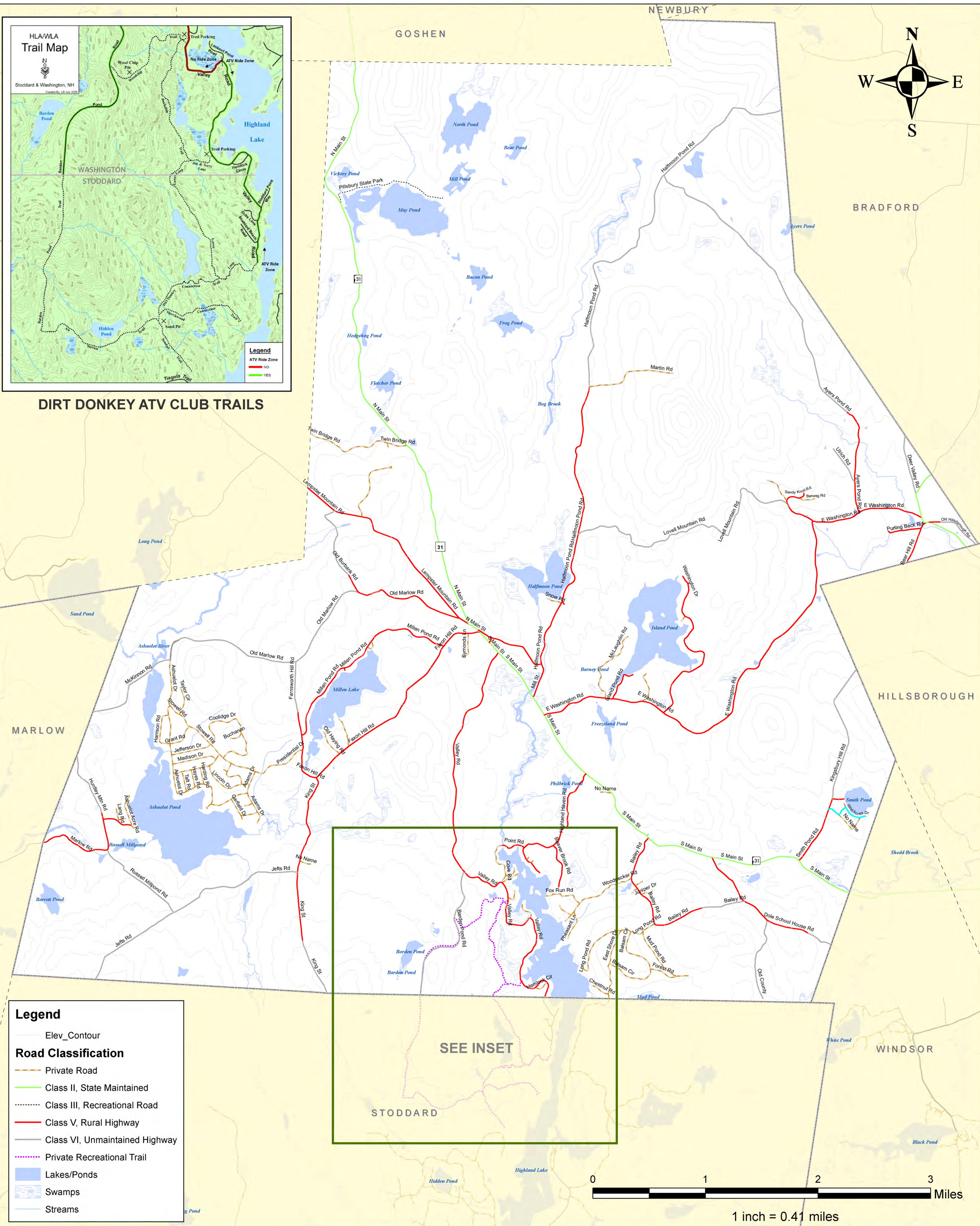

Road Classification Guide for UTV/ATV Use

Washington NH

The town of Washington owns and maintains approximately 32.7 miles of Class V roads and 22.3 miles of Class VI roads within the town limits. Class V roads are rural highways which the town maintains regularly, while Class VI are unmaintained highways and made subject to gates and bars. Class V highways (shown in red) may be used by a registered UTV at speeds less than 35 MPH. Class VI roads (shown in gray) may be used by a registered UTV or ATV. All operators must maintain proper licensing for the vehicle, and follow all state rules. Use of State Highways (NH 31) is prohibited, except to cross (no travel) by any recreational vehicle. Permission from the landowner is required for use of all private roadways.
