SYNOPSIS

Karen Keller, recently fired from her journalist job, decides to complete her deceased mother's book about "The Butcher," a surgeon in the early 1900's married to one of her ancestors. Her journey will take her to Escondido, a growing border city in South Texas, where "The Butcher" once owned the historical La Borde House, a local hotel and tourist destination for many ghost hunters. She will begin to uncover the truth about her family's history and Escondido, but will she be able to survive the secrets of the hotel's "Red Room"?


