## **AUDIT FISCAL YEAR 24-25**

- Audit was completed by: Amy Marsh (CPA), Anna Rae, and Paul Cristina
- After completion, the committee had 5 recommendations for the board:
  - Meeting minutes be housed in a shared location as well as emailed out as an attachment to the board so it can be recovered in the event of another issue.
  - Ensure that all spending has official vote recorded in the meeting minutes. (A few transactions were discussed without an official vote)
  - Check that spending does not exceed approved amount, and if it does, show a vote in the following meeting minutes to account for the difference.
  - Recent meeting minutes be available on the website so members can know most recent items being discussed.
  - Have a more robust process around unsold silent auction items. Create a deadline for selling or returning it to the donor.




## GENERAL FINANCE UPDATE


- We have made a total of \$8,500 so far this year with all fundraising efforts




