



RULES AND REGULATIONS

Nassau Swim Club requires all members and guests to adhere to the club's Rules and Regulations. The Board of Governors adopted the Rules and Regulations to assure the safe and sanitary operation and use of the pool facilities for the enjoyable recreation for all members and guests.

All members and guests are required to observe these Rules and Regulations. Parents are requested to read and explain the rules to their children. Failure to follow the Rules and Regulations by a member or their guest can result in the restriction or suspension of Swim Club privileges.

A. Management

1. The Pool Manager is in charge of the daily operation of the pool. It is the duty of the Pool Manager and his /her staff to operate maintains and polices the pool and its facilities. The Pool Manager operates at the direction of the Board of Directors.
2. The Pool Manager, Assistant Manager or lifeguards shall have the power to take immediate action to suppress disorderly or objectionable conduct in the pool area, and may eject the person or persons responsible for such conduct.
3. Failure to comply with the rules shall be considered sufficient cause for the Pool Manager to suspend the offending member for a period of one (1) to seven (7) days. The Board of Directors reserves the right to extend the suspension.
4. The Pool Manager and/or staff may, at their discretion, declare when the pool is closed for health, safety or weather conditions.

B. Pool Hours

1. Opening day for the Swim Club is the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. We are only open weekends until the end of the school year, in which the date will be determined by the Board of Governors and Provided Yearly. The Swim Club will be closed for the season after normal operating hours following Labor Day.
2. No member shall be admitted without presenting his or her membership card.
3. Membership cards are non-transferable. Any member who attempts to transfer his or her card will lose Swim Club privileges.
4. A fee of \$2.00 will be charged for the replacement of a lost card.
5. Rain Checks will not be issued after 4:00 p.m.
6. **Hours of Operation:**
Sunday through Thursday 11AM-9PM, Friday-Saturday 11AM-10PM
Full time hours begin mid-june. Hours will be sent for weekends leading up to opening. Hours in August may be adjusted
The pool will be cleared 15 minutes before closing.

C. Safety

1. No one is permitted in the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty.
2. Children swimming in the pool are solely the responsibility of their parents and are not under the supervision of the lifeguards.
3. Children swimming in the pool must wear rubber pants over swim diapers. No exceptions.
4. Children under 48" without a WATER TEST, must be accompanied by an adult in the water, and at arms length at all times.
5. Children over 48" without a WATER TEST, may swim unaccompanied by an adult in the 3 FT. Only.
6. Any Child using a floatation device, including but not limited to, swimmyies, life vest, puddle jumper; must be accompanied by an adult in the water and within arm's reach at ALL times.
7. To pass the WATER TEST: Children 12 and under must swim 1 lap and tread water for 60 seconds without touching the wall.
8. Children under 12 years old and over 10 years old may be permitted to enter the Swim Club alone if he or she can pass a test given by the manager or assistant manager. The manager or assistant manager will provide the child with certification of successful completion of the test. If they do not qualify, they must be accompanied by an adult; or qualified swimmer 16 years of age or over.
9. Use of **floatation devices or pool floats** will be permitted in the main pool at the discretion of the Pool Manager. No floating devices are permitted when there are 3 lifeguards on the stands. **Extra large floats or rafts, fitting more than one person, are not permitted. Glitter, Sequins or any other filling inside of a float, are not permitted on the pool grounds.**
10. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time. The area must be clear before diving. Only ONE Bounce is permitted. All divers must enter the diving area of the pool via the diving boards, and exit via the ladders.
11. **No glass containers will be brought onto the pool property. Anyone caught with glass containers will be suspended.**
12. No running, pushing, wrestling, dunking, rough play, etc. is permitted in the pool. No excessive noise or commotion within the pool area.
13. The Swim Club is not responsible for any accident, injury, loss or damage to person or property. All injuries must be reported to the Pool Manager or Assistant Manager and an accident report must be completed.

14. Members must drive slowly and carefully at all times in the pool parking area. The Swim Club is not responsible for loss or damage to automobiles on Swim Club property. No vehicle shall be parked in a manner that would obstruct the entrance, exits or roadways at any time.
15. No littering on Swim Club property.
16. No animals allowed on the Swim Club property at any time.
17. The Swim Club will not accept responsibility for belongings left on pool property.

D. Health and Sanitation

1. Appropriate swimwear is required – no jeans or cutoffs.
2. All persons must take a shower before entering the water. This is required by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
3. No member shall knowingly enter the pool enclosure, or permit a child or guest to do so, while suffering from any infectious, contagious or communicable disease.
4. All children in diapers must wear swim diapers. Cloth or disposable diapers are not permitted. Rubber pants must be worn over any diaper or swim diapers.
5. No food or beverage may be consumed in the pool or on the pool deck.
6. All trash must be deposited in the trash containers provided.
7. Alcoholic beverages may be permitted at Board discretion and sanctioned Adult Parties.
8. No gum or tobacco chewing in or around the pool deck and baby pool deck area.
9. Smoking on the pool grounds during swim meets & dive meets is prohibited.
10. Smoking of any kind, including but not limited to cigarette, cigar, vape, is ONLY permitted in the designated smoking area or off of Pool Grounds; including but not limited to; out front or in the parking lot. Designated smoking area will be located in the corner by the Horseshoe Pits.
- 11. There is a zero policy for Drug Use on Pool Grounds. Drug Use of any kind is immediate grounds for permanent membership termination, No Refunds.**

E. Guests

1. Each member will be allowed guest privileges.
2. Members with guests are required to register and pay guest fees upon entering the pool. An adult must accompany children under 12 years of age bringing a guest. Also, the guest must meet the age requirements and water test, in order to stay with a 12 year old member.
3. All guests shall be accompanied by a member who shall be responsible for them while they are at the Swim Club. When the member leaves, the guest must also leave. Guests must be made aware of the pool rules and regulations..
4. Only fully paid members may purchase guest booklets.
5. The Pool Manager may limit, at his/her discretion, the total number of pool guests when crowded conditions require such limitation.
6. Guest Fees and Hours are available on the website and are posted on the bulletin board.
7. **More than 5 Guests on one Membership number is considered a party. Please notify the Board of Directors if you would like to bring more than 5 guests so arrangements can be made for potential staffing, etc. The Pavilion by the baby pool can be reserved for parties when contacting the Board.**

F. Miscellaneous

1. Bicycles shall be parked in the bicycle stands in the prescribed area.
2. Use of roller blades or skateboards is prohibited within the pool area and picnic area.
3. Members will be held responsible for property damage caused by their family or guests.
4. **Bullying or Fighting of any kind will not be tolerated, and are grounds for termination from membership without refund.**
5. Use of grills is permitted at any time. Please be mindful of the amount of time spent using the grills, especially on Holidays & Holiday Weekends. These are shared by all and we would like to keep grills available, therefore, members are responsible for cleaning grills and utensils, and putting away grills, after each use. Use of your own utensils is encouraged as they are limited. Please notify a manager or Board Member if the propane is running low.
6. Any question as to the meaning or interpretation of the rules for the use of the Swim Club shall be determined by the Pool Manager and approved by the Board of Governors and will be posted on the appropriate bulletin board.
7. Any changes or additions to the Rules and Regulations for the use of the Swim Club may be made at any time by the Board of Governors and members shall be expected to abide by such changes or additions.
