Lighting Dry – Damp – Wet and more

Dry rating – for any area where NO moisture exists **Damp rating** – bathrooms with showers, covered outdoor areas

Wet rating – outdoors, direct exposure to rain

How to keep it all cohesive

-Try to stick to 2–3 finishes throughout. Our home is either black or brass, and I used rose gold in 2 spaces that I designed for ME (laundry, primary bath) -Use Keynote to put images of all choices on one page if you need a visual
