IN ORDER TO ADHERE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING AND CROWD LIMITS, with the permission of AKC, Shows #1 and #2 will be held over Saturday and Sunday, split as follows:

SATURDAY: Show #1 – AM – Sporting Breeds/Group, Hound Breeds/Group, Toy Breeds/Group, Non-Sporting Breeds/Group. Entry Limit Total 600.

SATURDAY: Show #2 – PM – Sporting Breeds/Group, Hound Breeds/Group, Toy Breeds/Group, Non-Sporting Breeds/Group. Entry Limit Total 600.

SUNDAY: Show #1 – AM – Working Breeds/Group, Terrier Breeds/Group, Herding Breeds/Group, Miscellaneous Breeds/Group, Junior Showmanship. Entry Limit Total 600.

SUNDAY: Show #2 – PM – Working Breeds/Group, Terrier Breeds/Group, Herding Breeds/Group, Miscellaneous Breeds/Group, Junior Showmanship. Entry Limit Total 600.

SUNDAY AFTERNOON, UPON COMPLETION OF ALL GROUPS: Show #1 Best in Show, followed by Show #2 Best in Show.

Monday, November 2 show will be in the traditional single-show format.

PLEASE NOTE LIMITS: SHOW #1 & SHOW #2 ARE LIMITED TO 600 ENTRIES EACH DAY.
No judge will be allowed to judge more than 100 dogs per day in either Show #1 or Show #2, and will not be allowed to judge more than 175 in any one day.
All Obedience Trials are limited to 5 hours • All Rally Trials are limited to 50.

Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment and subject to disciplinary hearing.

EXHIBITORS – PLEASE NOTE

- No grooming, no blowers, no fans in the building.
- Grooming only in the RV section or parking lot. No grooming in grassy areas.
- Overnight parking only in the Paid RV section.
- RV spaces without advance reservations \$50 per night, electric if available.
- All equipment must be removed every night in the Day Parking Lot per Expo regulations.
- RV RESERVATIONS & PAYMENT MAY BE COMPLETED ONLINE AT: www.cdadogfanciers.org Contact CDA Dog Fanciers at cdadogshow@gmail.com if you have questions regarding RV Parking
- There will be no communal grooming tent.
- No refund of admission fees.
- Day parking will be through Gate B on Government Way. The fee is \$5 per day.
- No Paid Reserved or Free Grooming Spaces.
- Grooming set ups found in nondesignated areas will be removed to be in compliance with Expo Center rules.
- Show Site is Handicapped Accessible.
- Indoor restrooms and showers are available.
- First Responder will be onsite.
- IT IS STRICTLY UNDERSTOOD THAT ALL CHILDREN ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENTS AND WILL BE SUPERVISED AND UNDER THEIR CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
- NO CRATES ALLOWED IN THE AISLES.
- No seating will be provided.
- KNOW YOUR ARMBAND NUMBER(S) PRIOR TO COMING RINGSIDE.
- No permanent crating anywhere in the building. Crates are allowed ringside during breed judging. Crates must be removed immediately after judging. The show committee reserves the right to remove any crate from the building. Obedience and Rally are only allowed in building while competing.
- Due to the constantly changing requirements we will post the most updated information related to rules in the Judging Program and the club website www.cdadogfanciers.org

**We ask that you cooperate with us on the amount of time
you spend in the building.**

**In order to limit building occupancy we anticipate allowing exhibitors
in the building fifteen minutes before showing and ask that you leave
if you are not needed for further competition.**

Dogs may not be left in the building.

The order of the day will be determined in the judging program.

No dogs in buildings overnight.

**Chairs will not be provided, you are welcome to use your own chair
at ring side if needed during breed judging, groups will not be
allowed to gather around the building.**

You will need to remove your chairs following breed judging.

**The building is closed to the public, but we will also need to limit the
spectating depending on the number of people in the building.**

crowded, take a break leave the building and visit the
Vendor area and come back if you want to observe.**

SUGGESTED BEST PRACTICES FOR THE WELL-BEING OF DOG SPORT PARTICIPANTS

The AKC supports each club's informed decision to reschedule, postpone or cancel their respective events, as well as supporting clubs ready to hold events in locations that are open and permit gatherings. As events resume across the country, people need to feel safe while enjoying their dog activities. The AKC urges clubs to take appropriate precautions for the benefit of their participants. Events need to be held in a manner that emphasizes the safety of participants and event officials over efficiency.

The following is a list of suggested best practices that may be helpful when planning or attending an event. Event locations, facilities and dates will differ. With a situation that is continually evolving, it is up to the clubs to determine the guidelines that best fit their event. In order to inform participants, specific guidelines established by the club/cluster should be published in the premium, show catalog, club website and posted on signage/flyers at their event.

GENERAL PRACTICES

- Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- Wash hands as frequently as possible. Have disinfecting spray at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
- Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own.
- Meals - Participants should consider bringing their own lunch/drinks.
- Vendors should follow retail guidelines for the area.
- Parking – Park with sufficient distance between vehicles if possible. If there is a parking fee, please bring exact change.
- Indoor show sites should work with facilities to have as many entrance/exits points open as possible. Hand sanitizer should be available at every entrance to the site and at multiple locations within the site.
- Parking/unloading staff should wear face coverings and sanitize their hands following the assistance of each individual.
- Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring a generator for electricity, bring personal use face coverings
- Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Bring rubber bands or armband clips to secure armband.
- Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate.
- While showing your dog, maintain social distances with other exhibitors.
- All classes should be called in catalog order to provide order and efficiency.
- Judges are to have the exhibitor display the oral exam and may personally examine the mouth ONLY if absolutely necessary. By the nature of the procedure, judges must conduct thumb exams.
- Judges should sanitize hands after examining each entry. Re-examining of dogs should be minimized.
- Judges are encouraged to personally pull ribbons for placements. Coupled with frequent hand sanitizing, this will help mitigate contact exposure.
- Participants are expected to follow state, local government, facility and event guidelines. Clubs should be prepared to enforce the guidelines that apply to their event. The conformation field reps will assist as always in an advisory capacity.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS & AT YOUR MOTEL SITE. We want to retain these facilities for future events. Remember, all complaints regarding conduct prejudicial to the sport will be dealt with in accordance with AKC Rules by the Show Committee. This includes dogs relieving themselves on the shrubbery outside the show buildings.

The Show grounds will be available to exhibitors at 12:00PM Friday. Dogs must be removed from the show site one hour after Best in Show judging on Monday.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- BUILDINGS will be open at 7:00AM and will close each day after Best in Show or completion of specialty/special events, unless otherwise noted in the judging program.
- THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS: All chairs, crates, and accessories must be placed within designated areas and must not block aisles, door exits, or fire extinguishers. Dogs must be on leash at all times.
- No flexi-leads on show grounds.
- Vehicles left in fire lanes will be towed.
- NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED IN CONFORMATION & OBEDIENCE OR RALLY AREAS.
- EXHIBIT HALLS: No grooming. Your crates may be placed in designated areas during the judging of your breed, but must be removed upon completion of your breed judging.
- DOG WASHING: There will no dog washing facilities available at these events.
- Any equipment left at ringside will be collected by CDADF and may be returned at owners expense. All items not claimed may become property of CDADF.
- No Paid Reserved or Free Grooming spaces..
- Please be prepared for inclement or cold weather.
- Obedience Building: Due to limited space there will be NO EARLY SETUPS. Crates must be removed at the end of class competition.
- Loading and unloading areas are extremely limited. Exhibitors are to keep parking blinkers on and are limited to 15 minutes.

USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (09/2020)

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,* household members and current assistants to professional handlers** may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

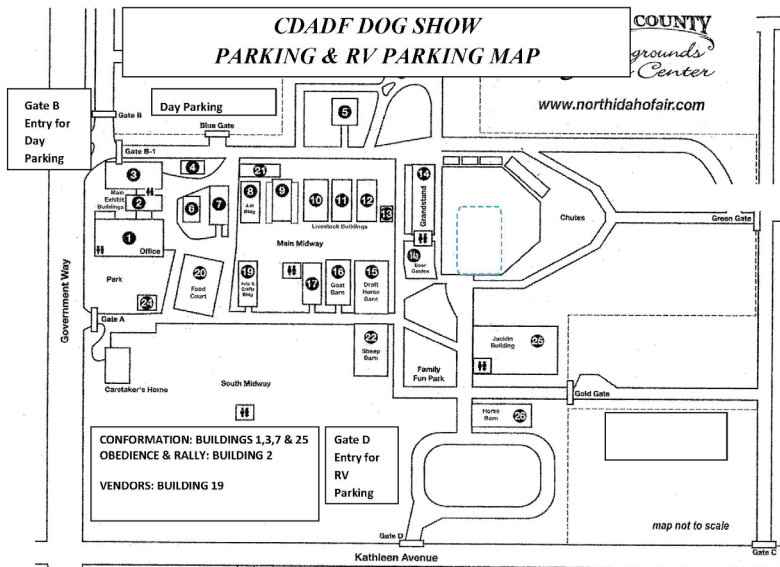

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS BEGINNER PUPPY

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. there will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months puppy in each Breed/ Variety, each Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Breed/Variety winner will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Placements. The Miscellaneous Class Competition will be judged same as above followed by a Miscellaneous 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. The Foundation Stock Service Class Competition will be judged same as above, followed by a FSS 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. All First Place Group Winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility

- An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed or Miscellaneous breed. FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for FSS entries.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.
- The Club may limit the Beginner Puppy judge to 20. If this occurs, an additional judge will be named on the Judging Program.

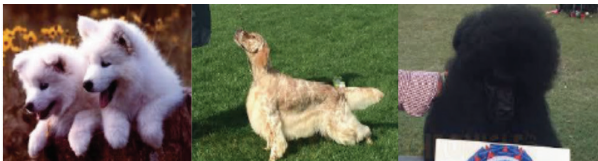

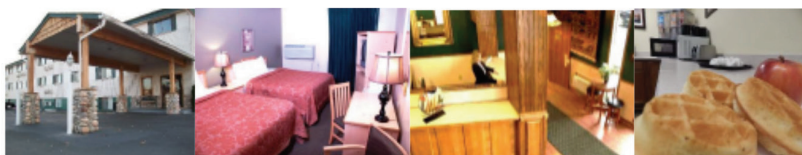

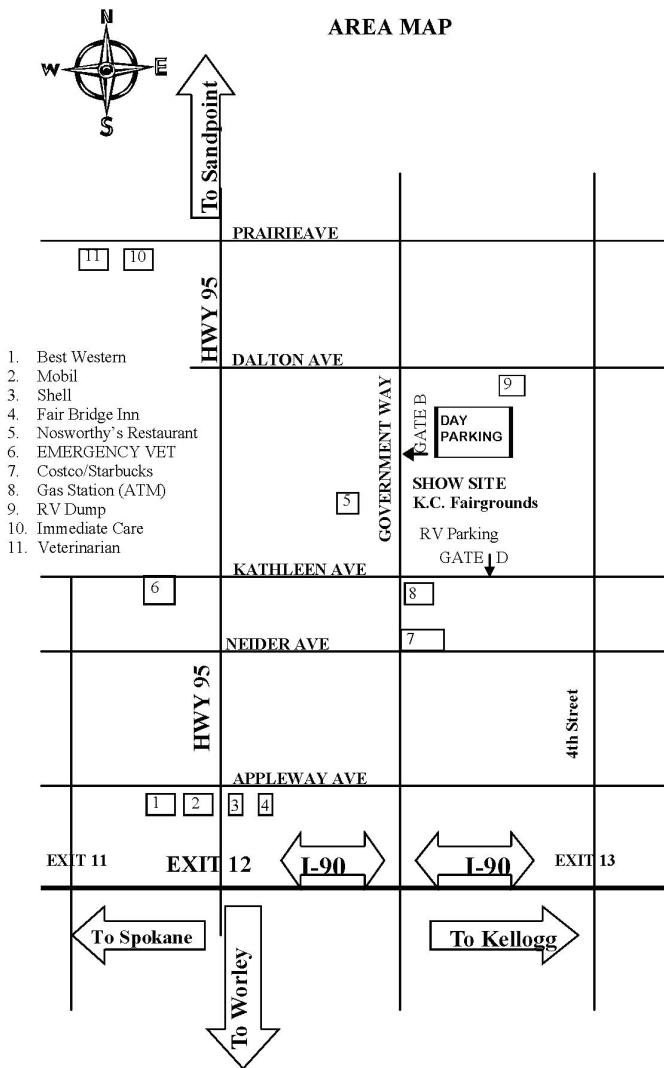

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent.
