Application process

Step 1: An applicant must attend at least one club meeting and be introduced as a visitor. An applicant form may be obtained at this meeting, and the first reading of the completed application will take place at the next meeting. A check in the amount of first year's dues must accompany this application.

Step 2: All applicants must meet with a member of the membership committee prior to the application vote.

Step 3: The applicant is required to attend the next regular Membership meeting unless they have participated in at least two meetings or events prior to the meeting where the second reading will occur (It is not mandatory for the applicant to attend this meeting if they have met the aforementioned requirements). After the second reading of the application, discussion may follow, and then a vote will be taken by the membership in attendance. The applicant will be notified via e-mail of the results.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will encourage high standards of sportsmanship by my behavior and I will not engage in malicious or intentionally misleading or exaggerated statements about other breeders, their dogs, or their breeding practices.
- I will help educate the public in the accepted standards of care and breeding practices.
- I will maintain high standards in the care of my dogs.
- I will not sell any dog without true and full representation, nor intentionally use misleading or untruthful statements in selling or advertising.
- I will not breed dogsfor the purpose of donating or selling to commercial dog wholesalers or pet shops.
- I understand that indiscriminate breeding may lead to overpopulation and contribute materially to the deterioration of my breed.
