Crates only allowed in the building while the breed is in the ring and must be removed immediately after the breed is judged

No grooming tables in the Show Building

Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment and subject to disciplinary hearing.

USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged **on the ground or on a ramp** through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Whippets, German Pinschers, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a **ramp or table** through all levels of competition: Mudi, Puli.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the **ground, ramp, or table** through all levels of competition: Miniature Bull Terriers.

The following breeds **must be judged on a ramp** through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (04/2024)

EXHIBITORS - PLEASE NOTE

No grooming, no blowers, no fans in the show building.

- Grooming only in the designated grooming areas, RV section or parking lot. No grooming in grassy areas.
- Overnight parking only in the Paid RV section.
- RV spaces without advance reservations \$75 per night, electric if available.
- All equipment must be removed every night in the Day Parking Lot per Expo regulations.

- Show Site is Handicapped Accessible.
- Indoor restrooms and showers are available.
- First Responder will be onsite.
- IT IS STRICTLY UNDERSTOOD THAT ALL CHILDREN ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENTS AND WILL BE SUPERVISED AND UNDER THEIR CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
- NO CRATES ALLOWED IN THE AISLES.
- KNOW YOUR ARMBAND NUMBER(S) PRIOR TO COMING RINGSIDE.
- No permanent crating anywhere in the Conformation building. Crates are allowed ringside during breed judging.
- Crates **MUST** be removed immediately after judging. The show committee reserves the right to remove any crate from the building. Obedience and Rally are only allowed in building during competition.

The order of the day will be determined in the judging program.

All dogs must be removed from the building within 1 hour after Best In Show.

SUGGESTED BEST PRACTICES FOR THE WELL-BEING OF DOG SPORT PARTICIPANTS

The AKC supports each club's informed decision to reschedule, postpone or cancel their respective events, as well as supporting clubs ready to hold events in locations that are open and permit gatherings. As events resume across the country, people need to feel safe while enjoying their dog activities. The AKC urges clubs to take appropriate precautions for the benefit of their participants. Events need to be held in a manner that emphasizes the safety of participants and event officials over efficiency.

The following is a list of suggested best practices that may be helpful when planning or attending an event. Event locations, facilities and dates will differ. With a situation that is continually evolving, it is up to the clubs to determine the guidelines that best fit their event. In order to inform participants, specific guidelines established by the club/cluster should be published in the premium, show catalog, club website and posted on signage/flyers at their event.

GENERAL PRACTICES

- Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Parking - Park with sufficient distance between vehicles if possible. Please bring exact change \$5.00
- All classes should be called in catalog order to provide order and efficiency.
- Judges are to have the exhibitor display the oral exam and may personally examine the mouth ONLY if absolutely necessary. By the nature of the procedure, judges must conduct thumb exams.
- Participants are expected to follow state, local government, facility and event guidelines. Clubs should be prepared to enforce the guidelines that apply to their event. The conformation field reps will assist as always in an advisory capacity.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- BUILDINGS will be open at 7:00AM and will close each day after Best in Show or completion of specialty/special events, unless otherwise noted in the judging program.
- THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS: All chairs, crates, and accessories must be placed within designated areas and must not block aisles, door exits, or fire extinguishers. Dogs must be on leash at all times.
- No flexi-leads on show grounds.
- Vehicles left in fire lanes will be towed.
- NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED IN CONFORMATION & OBEDIENCE OR RALLY AREAS.
- EXHIBIT HALLS: No grooming. Your crates may be placed in designated areas during the judging of your breed, but must be removed upon completion of your breed judging.
- DOG WASHING: There will be dog washing area behind the Jacklin Building. Bring all needed equipment.
- Any equipment left at ringside will be collected by CDADF and may be returned at owners expense. All items not claimed may become property of CDADF.
- Please be prepared for seasonal or warm weather.
- Obedience & Rally Building: Due to limited space there will be **LIMITED SETUPS**.
- Loading and unloading areas are extremely limited. Exhibitors are to keep parking blinkers on and are limited to 15 minutes.

Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed competition. This will be followed by Best Owner-Handled.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN Class divided: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

RESERVE JUNIOR HANDLER: After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

Transfers will be allowed at this trial per AKC Regulations.

**The trophy sponsors reserve the right to substitute a trophy or prize for something of equal or greater value.
All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. No trophies will be mailed.**

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,* household members and current assistants to professional handlers** may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

The Coeur d'Alene Dog Fanciers members hope you will find this information helpful in making your attendance plans. Your cooperation is appreciated.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All parking is a privilege extended by the show-giving club & the Kootenai County Fairgrounds. They reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who uses abusive language, argues with parking personnel or attempts to circumvent the rules & regulations. All parking is at your own risk. Violators will be towed at owner's expense. The show-giving club & the Fairgrounds assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.
- Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in any landscaped area at the Fairgrounds. Failure to observe the rules may result in an Event Hearing.
- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep & leave the area clean. Everyone must police their area prior to leaving & pick up all trash, this includes dog hair & cigarette butts.

- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available for both the general & reserved parking areas. Handicapped parking does not mean "Inside the Fairgrounds" or "Near the rings." It only indicates a readily accessible surface, but may be some distance from the show rings. Please send a copy of your handicap permit with your parking reservation. Handicap placard or plates **MUST** be visible on the vehicle
- In case of emergency, a member of the Show Committee will be available at all times.
- ALL OVERNIGHT PARKING UNITS MUST BE SELF-CONTAINED. No dumping of gray water or sewage. All units must have own fire extinguisher on board.
- NO PARKING IN FIRE LANES OR ANY AREA NOT DESIGNATED FOR RESERVED OR DAY PARKING. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.

- **Cars left in fire lanes will be towed. All equipment must be removed every night from the Day Parking Lot.**

RESERVED RV PARKING

- No electrical cords may stretch across roadways or sidewalks.
- No splitters may be used.
- All tow vehicles must fit in the space provided. No blocking roadways. Otherwise you will be asked to park in overflow parking area.

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. there will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months puppy in each Breed/ Variety, each Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Breed/Variety winner will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Placements. The Miscellaneous Class Competition will be judged same as above followed by a Miscellaneous 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. The Foundation Stock Service Class Competition will be judged same as above, followed by a FSS 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. All First Place Group Winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility

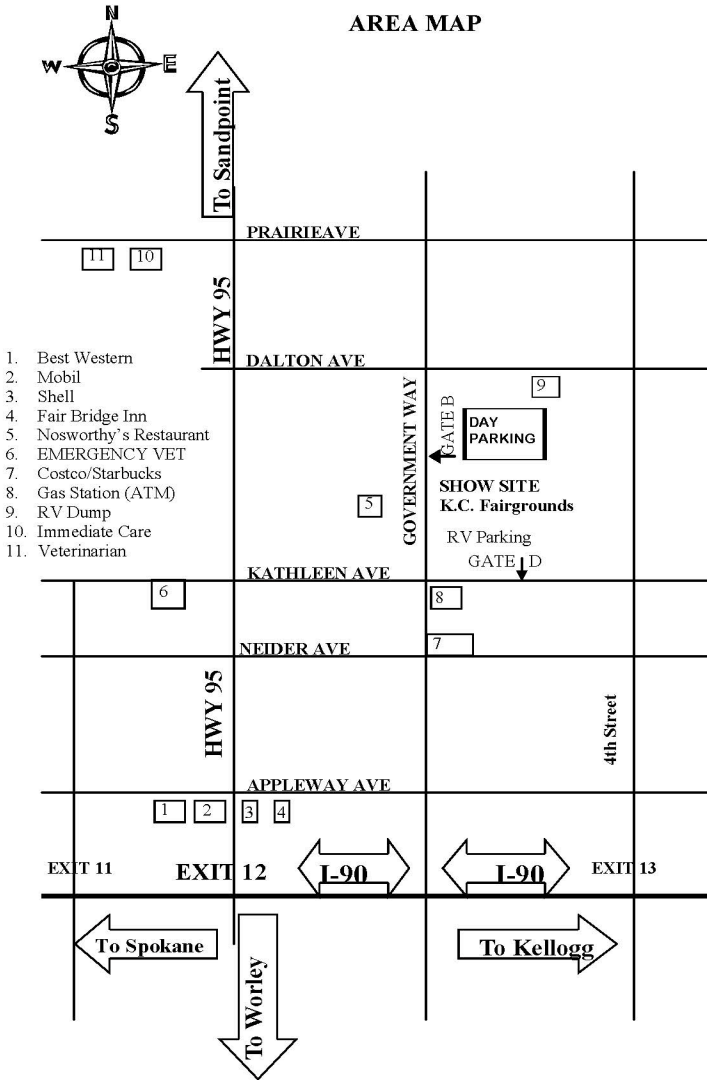
- An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed or Miscellaneous breed. FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for FSS entries.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.
- The Club may limit the Beginner Puppy judge to 20. If this occurs, an additional judge will be named on the Judging Program.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS



The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: • First entry of a dog in Conformation or Obedience, a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee, plus a \$3.50 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog.

- First entry and each additional entry of a dog in Agility or Rally, a \$3.50 Service Fee.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.

CGC TESTING

The American Kennel Club's Canine Good Citizen test (CGC) is a certification program that evaluates dogs in simulated everyday situations in a noncompetitive atmosphere. Dogs that pass the CGC test are considered reliable family and community members and will receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club.

The 10 test items on the CGC test are practical, functional behaviors that every dog should have to be welcomed in the community.

1. Accepting a friendly stranger: Evaluator approaches and pretends to shake hands with handler (hands 6- 12" apart). Evaluator does not touch dog.
2. Sitting politely for petting: Evaluator pets dog; dog must show no shyness or resentment.
3. Appearance and grooming: Evaluator inspects dog, combs or brushes lightly, examines ears and each front foot.
4. Out for a walk: Handler takes dog for a short walk including right turn, left turn, about turn and stop.
5. Walking through a crowd: Dog and handler walk close to several people; dog may show causal interest but not jump up.
6. Sit and down on cue/Staying in place: Handler shows that dog can do both sit and down, then chooses a position, leaves dog and goes to the end of a 20 ft. line, and returns immediately
7. Coming when called: With dog still on 20 ft. line from Test 6, handler walks out 10 ft. and calls the dog.
8. Reaction to another dog: Two handlers and dogs approach, pretend to shake hands (hands 6-12" apart), exchange pleasantries, then move on.
9. Reaction to distractions: Distractions are presented; dog may not panic or show aggression.
10. Supervised separation: Handler goes out of sight for 3-min. Dog is held on a 6-ft. leash by an evaluator.

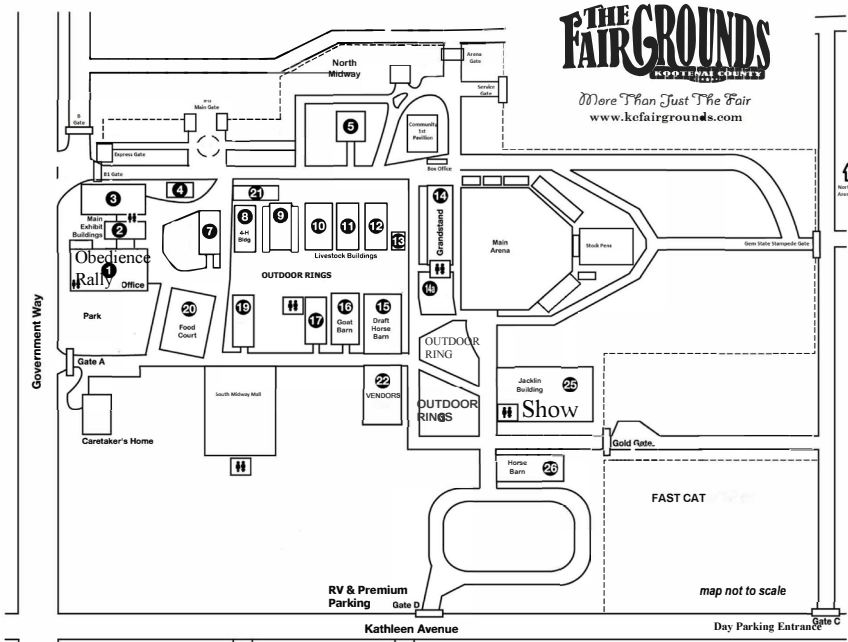
