THAT CANCEL BIBLICAL HOPE **How To Fix It**

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Intro

My name is Andre Santos. I am a Christian Life Coach. For a long time God has been speaking to me through the first half of Jeremiah chapter 17. You could really benefit a whole lot if you read this everyday of your life. The curse of humanity and the blessing of humanity is there [you have to understand why]. On one side there is a curse, on the other side there is a huge blessing. Its about the heart, trust and hope.

As Christians we have really focused on love and faith. We recognize our necessity for love, how much we have it and how much we need it, and the same for faith. I believe that we have not seen the importance or given importance to hope. No one says how much they lack or how much they have these days. It's an off topic. We have not seen how important and how essential hope is. Possibly the text of the apostle Paul that states: "and now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these [is] charity"¹, has influenced us. But I know that when you properly understand hope your life will completely change. It will transform you and empower your Christian witness, because hope is a precursor to faith and hope is a precursor to love.

Before the New Testament the focus of God's people was on the presence of God (making a temple, etc). And now at conversion it is common belief that the problem of the presence of God is solved. It is believed that you now have God's presence after you convert. We have several verses that bring this conclusion [that I am not bringing up here, as they are well known. I am making no argument against them].

Hope is a mystery for most people. Its a wonder of the past. It was a prize or a tool. But now a days, the idea is "we have everything", including the presence of God. This is a common myth or delusion. This paper demystifies hope, and the illusion that we have everything. You will have a complete understanding of hope and understand that if you don't use it properly it doesn't do anything for you. And you will see that hope is the tool that robs water from our garden, if we don't understand it. The reality is we are using it, but we may be fooled by the world concerning it, and its significance, and power.

What you believe dictates what you hope. What you hope on dictates what you trust. An example of this: lets say you want to fly by airplane (for the first time). First you believe the airplane company will be able to do this; after you purchase the ticket, you hope the airplane will do what you purchased. When you board the plane you still hope, but it's when you sit down and buckle up and sit back (forget) and relax-when you trust. If you don't have action, you are in the belief stage (most of the time). After repeated action you skip to faith. Hope does not mean you have action. But when you have-the action-its after (or when) you trust. Faith is based on trust.

Faith (in the Lord) is evidence that you trusted in the Lord-when you deny a trust that is worldly. If your faith in the Lord does not lead you to deny the world, then its not really faith. You can work on your beliefs, hope, and build holy confidence. After you have perfected your trust - then comes faith.

I started to apply God's principles concerning hope in my life and I am overwhelmed by the spiritual prosperity that its produced. God started to show up in my life, mostly speaking to me through dreams. I am compelled to share my understanding here, as someone who follows Jesus and desires to be like Him.

This is the most powerful message you are going to hear. It has the power to rip you from darkness to light [if you obey], because this is (though hidden) an essential part of the full gospel. There is a high cost to it, 3 fold. But the gospel has a high cost as well. If you are willing to pay the high cost of the gospel then this is small change. If you did not understand the gospel, this is going to be a huge light for you. What I share here, I have never heard from anyone, but this is a logical presentation of God's word. May God grant you the grace to understand what is missing on your side! I pray heaven opens up over you! And deliverance and blessing according to your faithfulness in every detail!

MISTAKE NO 1



You Put Your Hope In The World

[I am not talking about creation when I say "hope in the world". We see God's hand in creation, or creation points us to believe in God. There is nothing wrong in hoping for sunlight or a sunrise. This is creation. We have a natural desire for creation, like when you smile you desire to see a smile, or when you greet someone, you hope that you are greeted back. Also nothing wrong when you hope for something good, like when you order food and you hope that you get what you ordered. Nothing wrong with hoping for justice (or things like it). This is a God given virtue. **Going forward when I write "world": I mean the system of the world**].

The truth is, If you put your hope in the world you automatically cancel your hope in the Lord. This teaching has not been taught before. But this is the most biblical teaching on this subject. If someone has experienced the blessing brought on by this teaching they would have taught it before hand. So this may be by God's grace your opportunity to understand and apply this teaching to your life, so you enter into God's promise on this subject.

Let me first try to make the connection to Matthew 6:24 "No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon." What often happens is when we start to believe and get to know the Lord, we have an old system we operate in, or an "old master". One day by God's grace you may see the difference and want to be under His kingdom - the "new master". In this text the idea is that you have a servant with 2 masters. In the same way Jesus said it does not work, 2 hopes does not work: hope for the world and hope for the Lord. One pulls you in one direction and the other pulls you in an opposite direction. You will "hold to the one, and despise the other". This is the answer to why hope is canceled. Think of it like friends with opposite interests, when you are with one doing ABC, you might tell the other: "I will see you later" or "I am busy". In your mind, hope for the world & hope for the Lord, on your terms, it may work. This is a common deception. You have to understand a biblical principle: what you sow is what you reap. He is the Living God and rewards you according to your doing. If God promised to hang around with you every now and then when you are not with your other hope, this is not so bad, If occasionally God is around. No big deal, right? [People actually treat the situation this way]. But if God really wants to be with you, and fill you with His Spirit, should you deviate or defer your hope?

An exercise may be needed so that you understand/see your highest hopes: Try to make an honest list of the desires you had during a time period. An example: If you tracked down your heart in one day. How much did you race for your favorite brand of XYZ? What's the emotion when you put on your brand sweater, sport jacket, ring, or jewel (s)? Who were you dying to see at a certain time? How about your next emotion, and next, etc. Go over the list and ask yourself: Why you have this and that desire? Is there a hope behind it? Is there a trust you built somewhere? And what principle or origin is that trust from?

When you hope in the world, afterwards that turns to trust in your heart. For example. Personal story: I grew up around coffee. How many times I heard about it from every source you could think of, I can't recall [an overload]. I learned about what it supposedly does. I started to trust coffee to do certain things for me: help me get up; help me when I am tired. I became a moderate coffee drinker (heavy when needed). From desire, to hope, to trust. Coffee is an item in the world system. [It's a device the world uses]. And how does God view my actions? He views this as a 2nd hope. The message the world gives behind coffee is not His. I could say at the time my attitude was: "I am believing in coffee as if I am believing in another master. [In this case, I am believing the words of the "old master"]. What am I believing? That coffee will fulfill my every need concerning tiredness and sleepiness, that coffee will give me strength and get me going/on my feet". And my trust is given away to the world for something

I should be trusting the Lord for, because strength and might is His. He makes one strong and another weak, as He desires and when He desires.

"Hast thou not known? Hast thou not heard, [that] the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? [there is] no searching of his understanding. He giveth power to the faint; and to [them that have] no might he increaseth strength"¹.

Does it mean that I can't drink coffee or you can't from now on? I can drink coffee. You can drink coffee. I can like drinking coffee, but if I believe that coffee is my source of strength, like the world says, instead of "the Lord is my strength", than that is the problem here. [It's my attitude towards coffee]. I figured it out that if I reprogram the meaning in my mind, for things like coffee, I can turn the simple things of life into moments of faith (it takes repetition). An oyster takes an irritation and turns it into a pearl. This is a place the text fits: "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God"². Things like "coffee" help me reprogram my faith, I just have to slowly change my beliefs around it. [It takes time]. [And without that irritation do I have the same faith that I would have without it? Definitely not!]. If I was able to find the blessing you can too, that is my motivation. You don't have to live in a monastery. I don't. Just re-think and work it out. "Work out your salvation with fear and trembling"³.

If you have hope in the world, in any shape or form, you canceled your hope in the Lord. The truth is that we all start life on this side of the table. As soon as you are born we start to hope in creation and then we proceed on to hope in the world and the things of the world. Some come to knowledge of faith, but who continues to have hope in the world? This is the question at hand. The common idea is "I live and breathe in the world, shouldn't I believe in the world". Jeremiah gave us the word of the Lord. The secret to get on the other side of the table is to cancel all hope in the world and obey [Part B] Jeremiah 17:7-8 "Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit."

What is the curse of mankind? This is the problem that you have to identify. This is everyones problem. Everyday we have to deal with this problem. The curse is the removal of the presence of God. Any hope in the world does that. You may think "I hope in my job, school, this & that, how can God curse me for this? Doesn't everybody do that?" Well didn't Eve, the first woman, do similar when she listened to the devil? She did practically the same thing. What did she do? She hoped/trusted in something other than God. It was a piece of fruit. [It does not matter what it is]. What was the message behind that sale and origin? This is what is important. What did this do for man? Their action and attitude brought the curse over humanity that we experience today. The attitude we often don't identify may be our snake poison. [Are we poisoning others?].

a. Let Sunday be the Lord's day and I will live the rest of the days a worldly life.

b. The movies I watch are worldly and I can watch one spiritual one out of 20 and still live a holy life.

c. The friends I have are worldly and I can on Sunday's listen to a nice sermon that will fix me up.

d. The worldly songs I sing and give my heart out to-don't affect my spiritual life.

A, b, c, & d: These are all deceptions and tragic statements or ideas that totally show a heart that has hope and trust in the world.

The devil said to Jesus: "All this power I will give thee, and the glory of them"⁴. The world is the stage that this offer keeps repeating at varying levels and degrees to mankind. Since the beginning the devil uses the world for this. It is hard not to hope in the world, it offers a lot of things at the most convenient times (this is often the common theme and trap), but if you do the reality is you are missing out on your provision and blessing, because God also sees you do this. [Should you question every offer you receive from the world? Yes, you should! I.e. "Is this something else that will help deviate and defer hope?"; "Does this cooperate with status/power/glory/ego?"]. Unfortunately this is a sad story, we all bought in at some point in our lives. [You can buy out too!]. You can't please God with trust in the world. And we will not see the continuation of the book of Acts this way.

MISTAKE NO 2



You Put Your Hope In Man

This may be the hardest thing to hear because no one says this or you may have never heard this: but the truth is, if you put your hope in anyone you will miss the blessing and provision God has for you, because the reality is it is hard to say you are not trusting in that person to some degree afterwards.

God reveals this in Part A: [Jeremiah 17:5-6 "Thus saith the LORD; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD. For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land and not inhabited."]

Hope is often at the automatic level within us. We do this so much that we don't see it or label this. It is really at the unconscious level. Discernment and wisdom is needed. In Jeremiah 17, it goes as far as to say the heart is desperately wicked. [This is a light from God- everyone has a heart like this]. The way I explain this is the heart is like a light house, it searches constantly for an object of hope, so that it can point its light, at times it even brings up people, moments, events from memory to do this. Why do people scroll on their phone for hours? They need something to hope on, they have a lot to give, and time to burn, often they search for people that match in someway, or they need to keep scrolling because no one matches and their heart wants a more perfect object of hope. [Giving away hope, appears to be what the soul wants to do]. A word of wisdom - no one and nothing is perfect, only God. Why are there so many channels, menus, flavors and options in life? It's because these things are made to get your hope [and we often do things so people hope in us]. People want your hope (a lot of people are dying for attention), because it earns them views, money, power, etc. [The world constantly allows us to cancel our hope in God].

God sees what you do with your hope. What is going on is God is looking to step into your life, and when you misuse hope you hinder this action. Like a bank account with \$100, if you give it all away, do you have any money? Or if you give some percentage away to someone else, and you give the rest to God, is God really satisfied with that? With a 10th of your hope (like a tithe), or a dollar of hope? He is God, so when you put hope in someone you remove God from the picture. We often get the silence of God in our lives. [This reaction is the normal state of being for mankind]. God "disappears". If your hope is in someone else, why do you expect God to bless you? If He blesses someone that has hope in another person [besides Him] that means He blesses wrong doing and wavering, when that is not anywhere biblical, farthest from the truth. And we want God to curve to us and bless us when we are wrong. What a deception! The greatest blessing, really, is God's presence. You make man greater than God with your center of attention in your heart, when you hope in man. Who then is your heart relying on? Technically we are not aware this is happening most of the time. Its just happens unconsciously and then we live mediocre christian lives (void of the presence of God). We have the shadow of God if anything this way. We live in the shadow this way.

What good does it do when you put your hope in an acquaintance or prospect/client, anyways? How often people forget or are stuck in their priorities of the day and completely fall off track from their commitments. How many don't even show up, or follow up? The person may remember only when they see you and start the "hey lets get together"/ spiel, again. The truth is human nature doesn't produce attraction in this environment. We don't love this. You will tend to get bitter (not better) as time passes and the frequency that the particular person does not follow through, if you put your hope in that person. [Is it their fault that you deposited your hope in them? Isn't it a better stance that you take responsibility, instead of blaming someone for your actions. Otherwise you may get triggered and close the door entirely for this environment or that person, potentially losing a connection or what the Lord has for you]. Because when you hope in someone, your trust goes as well. And your heart wants some sort of

return on investment, like a bank. If you do this, the tendency is you will live your life on this level and be dependent on individuals for happiness or your heart's return on investment. What a terrible cycle to get stuck in, because more often than not, you may lose your investment of hope. But let's say you don't put your hope in the person in the first place, you are free and un-triggered.

We often put our hope in spiritual leaders, and we allow them to generate the content that God has for us in a sole effort. If you are trusting in 2 men, or 1 man, the text of Jeremiah 17:5-6 also applies here. This may be a hard word, but the truth is cursed is man that trusts in man and makes man his strength, and whose heart departs from the Lord [for lack of attention, i.e. if you pay attention, eventually your heart will follow along]. God is not limited by time, distance, space, etc., but we limit ourselves by our ignorance. It is as simple as misusing hope and putting your trust in someone. The evil here is like the cup of coffee example. Lack of re-thinking or reprogramming and we miss out on the blessing, we don't establish faith, and we end up depending more on people then on God.

Jesus said the truth will set you free. Jesus did not come to destroy. He came to set free. This text is part of the truth. If you embrace it you will be on the path to be set free. This is the baseline for God to remove the curse. It is like the law of gravity. Will you fall? Everyone falls. Man is fallen from grace. Will you hover or fly? Now that is the question. Embrace the text [Part A] like the law of gravity, maybe the wind will start to go in your favor instead of against you. And you will experience the law of aerodynamics [Part B].

Part B: [Jeremiah 17:7-8 "Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit."]

The truth is, the church is the light of the world. The structure of the church should be focused on hope on the Lord in the midst of the church, because the church is the body of Christ. That means there is no pastor, he is just a left hand, there is no leader, he is a right hand. If you don't focus on any one for hope, this is the foothills for blessing for you and the congregation, because if you start to hope only in the Lord - this is everything.

What is today's major error in church structure? Most churches are pyramid structure. They are set up for the glory of man. One or 2 men get the glory (at the top) or center stage. If you set up a man or 2 to be center stage by default the structure is locked. Cursed is man that trusts in man applies here. When does the congregation point its hope to God within the midst? Behind the scenes? If its eyes are on 2 men? Or solo leader/voice? It is not biblical to give the glory that is God's to a man. The ones that are "greater" should not be the only ones allowed to speak, locking the content or "grace". This is a potential "spiritual" trap. Instead they should be surrounding the congregation, and within the congregation, because the content, gift, life, power, grace, etc, is within the body of Christ. If a leader has a gift, gifts come after service. You should have leaders that are servants. Jesus established the model for us. Why is no one using it?

[You should not be in an environment where there is predominantly fear/intimidation/manipulation and no freedom to introduce new topics or edification of the body by the body. Remember the house church. I recommend you don't give tithes in a "spiritual" trap, instead remember the orphans, widows and strangers.]

MISTAKE NO 3



You Put Your Hope In Yourself

The truth is, If you put your hope in yourself, you come under the curse [in Part A], you will miss the blessing and provision God has for you. Most of the time when you hope in yourself, this hope builds a reliance, in other words: trust, and the same principle applies that is in Jeremiah 17:5-6. We start out away from the presence of God. So, the curse is really a normal way of life for people, and why people live mediocre lives. [They are perfectly fine living that way, blind to the truth].

[Part A] Jeremiah 17:5-6 "Thus saith the LORD; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD. For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land and not inhabited."

Romans 3:10-12 "As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one."

There is no one that is good. No one can turn to God on his or her own. We all need grace to turn to God. God has to turn towards us and grant us grace to turn to Him. There is no one who has spiritual hunger or thirst without God giving spiritual hunger or thirst to him or her. This is also a gift. Even someone that is baptized, needs grace to hunger, thirst, turn, pray, seek & find God, afterwards.

The best thing I ever did for myself, was to lose hope in myself. I believe in myself¹, but when it comes to hope in myself I cancel it, and put my hope in the Lord.

The book of Joel states: "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit"². Why are we not seeing this happen today? When I read the Acts of the Apostles the same question comes to mind. Where is the grace of God today? People are believing too much in themselves. There is a huge Tower of Babel in our midst. This is greater than Babel, even eclipsing the church.

Isaiah 57:15 states: "For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones." Yet again God is looking for the humble.

Jesus said in Matthew 18:3 "Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven". This is a serious problem for high hoping man. But for a believer, the best reality, because we get the Kingdom.

God does not change. We either learn to apply His principles, apply them and change and step into his provision, or most likely everything will stay the same and tend to get worse or be really dull. This is the reason people look for excitement outside of "God". The most exciting things in my life, God is doing.

¹ I believe in myself to a certain degree. I believe that I exist and I am a work of grace. [It's a work in progress].You have to believe that you exist [that you are a work of grace]. God is building you up with good things: wisdom, self worth, self compassion, to name a few. If you don't believe in yourself this could be a victory for the devil, because too low self esteem is problematic. Too much self esteem (believing too much in yourself) is problematic as well (acting conceited or arrogant).

Man thinks he is good. Why should he be humble?

Man does not understand the need to be humble when he thinks he is good.

There is a deception in baptism: that God makes someone who is baptized good, and this person does not need God to be good anymore. The more you don't have the presence of God the worse off you are, even if you are baptized. What is one of the prophetic names of Jesus? Emanuel - God with us. He is the man of heavenly vision and hope, even in the grave. We have to learn from Him and be like Him. Jesus is the only one that is good and without sin. And the life we live, it is a life of faith. Faith is momentary dependence on God throughout the day. It's a repositioning work that you do on your own, in your heart, with your mind. And we do this until the end or the day we die. We have a calling to hope and trust in God. The grace of God is drawing us out of darkness or the valley of the shadow of death. There is no growth if we don't move out of darkness, and into His light.

["I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith. For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office: So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another. Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching; Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.

Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good. Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality.

Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not. Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep. Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits."³]

How To Fix It

What do you feel about what you read, and what I presented as truth to you? It really depends about your background and your spiritual journey. Answer a question here and I will try to give you the best "How to fix it" for you.

1. Did it make sense? Where do you fit? Scenario a, b, c, d, or e

a. It did not make sense the explanations that I read. I want to say I believe, but I really don't believe. If you could help me understand? I would appreciate it.

b. I feel like it made sense. I am someone that God has given me more spiritual light these days. And this could be part of an awakening or refreshing from the Lord, because you answered what I needed to know from those texts you mentioned. The understanding that I needed, you gave it to me. I desire to know more and listen to the complete gospel message.

c. This could be exactly why it feels like I bought something and I never got it, when I gave my life to Jesus. Or I had it for some time, and it could be true that I am not in the blessing like I should be. My life is not all blessing and goodness. I heard the gospel in the past and I was baptized. I have had hard times or I am in a hard time. It could be true that I don't have the blessing that I want and I don't see the presence of God like I want to. I want to live the continuation of the book of Acts and a spiritual life.

d. In the past I would agree. But I don't have the light I had before. I do want to get out of darkness and come to the light, but I just don't have the will to do so. I am anchored to the world, my desires are worldly. I know there is sin, and pleasing the flesh is sin. What do I do?

e. I am a believer, and you found the right crowd. This is to me a revelation or an awakening call.

If a or b fits you - See How to fix it "a" or "b".

If c or e fits you - See How to fix it "c" & "e".

If d fits you - See how to fix it "d".

How To Fix It "a"or"b"

The most special people are the ones who don't understand but really are interested. In some manner they know that God exists, but need to hear more. So it is necessary that someone walk with you at your pace.

Hope is a huge part of the gospel message. This may be the missing link for a lot of people. When we come to the Lord we have to bring our hope as well, often people come to the Lord with a dual hope. As part of the awakening a proper understanding of hope is needed, because God does not want you to come to Him with any hope in the world (or self or man). So it is important to properly address this and explain this and have a complete gospel message.

I would like to have an opportunity to fill in the gaps for you and give you a complete gospel message from the bible. If you corrected your hope you may be more than half way there because without faith it is impossible to please God.

The grace of God is really in the people. And God wants to be the shining star that shines among them. And if we are stripped of man's glory, it will most likely be that He will be there. For He says "I dwell with the lowly and contrite of heart".

How To Fix It "c" or "e"

In the Old Testament, the people had to prepare a structure for the presence of God to manifest on the earth, in a holy way. Jesus took away all that structure with his death and resurrection. That means that we are the only "structure" in the way of the presence and manifestation of God. My body is not in the way, specifically its the mindset and programs that I hold sacred.

After one converts a paradigm shift is needed to truly host the presence of God. If you run the programs you ran before you knew God, can you truly be filled with God when you are full of your previous paradigms? We either adapt our program to the Holy Spirit or we limit or shut off the grace of God. We may have God's grace for sometime after conversion, but we can even go as far as removing the grace of God because of hardheartedness. God once said "My spirit shall not always strive with man" in Genesis 6:3a, this was spoken in the past to reveal God's character today. We know that God does not change. So we have to change or adapt, otherwise we are not going to see God's word fulfilled in our lives.

[Let me know how far you get at some point, and what the Lord leads you to do. If so, God bless!]. I am sure there will be plenty of people with success stories without any further help from me.

How To Fix It "d"

What happens is that we often change our anchors. People are really manipulated on this earth. We often are victims of the world system. We get on a new moment or new wave, because of a suggestion, by accident, or we are triggered by someone and we often leave something that was good. There are people who still show up even though in their heart they left already. People move from whim to whim, to desire to desire. At one point it may have worked - going to church or similar. In the past you most likely accepted or created anchors for God and His Kingdom. [In Hope 10.0 I explain anchors].

You need to accept that the anchors you have are really your drivers. Jesus talks about this in Revelation when He tells John to write a letter to the church in Ephesus in Rev 2:4-5 "Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent". When He says "thou hast left thy first love", this means that they exchanged their anchors. And the golden candlestick, He is talking about removing His glory because the church has new emotional ties and they are just doing the motion of church, because of habits, commitments or something. [Maybe their conscious tells them "there is nothing better to do on Sunday"]. He is saying that He is going to abandon the church. And we see this daily. Everyone has been a witness of a church event that was missing the grace of God (or the glory of God).

What is a church that was abandoned by Jesus? He said its a church that left their first love, which He removes His glory from the church after some time. So, its just a religious structure. It might be called "church" and look like "church", and everyone is dressed like "church", everyone talks like "church", etc., but Jesus is not there, or does not show up. Pretty much the scenario is back to the curse of Adam and Eve¹ or Jeremiah 17:5-6 [Part A].

I think a person in this scenario really needs to rethink their anchors or really understand what is going on in their heart. Coaching is a really good resource, because part of coaching is understanding anchors. [At least in the coaching that I do].
