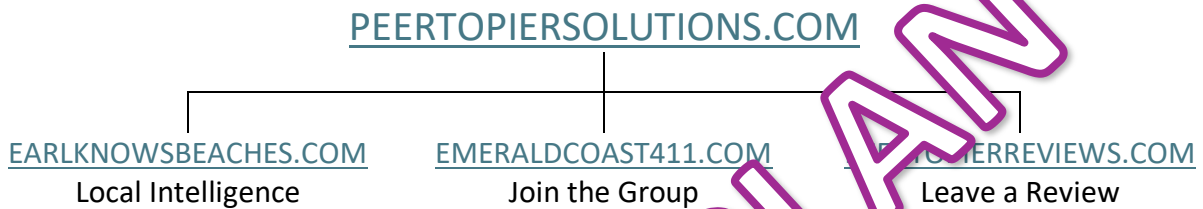

Conditions Snapshot — Destin / HarborWalk Village

Late July (July 26 – August 1)

Air / Heat Expectations

- Typical highs: **88–93°F**
- Heat index frequently **95–105°F**
- Mornings are the most comfortable outdoor window.
- Mid-afternoon heat can be intense, especially on pavement and docks.

Gulf Water Temperature

- Typically **84–87°F**
- Very comfortable for swimming, snorkeling, paddleboarding, and floating.
- Little temperature shock entering the water.

Water Clarity Expectations

- Generally **good to excellent** during calmer periods.
- Visibility can temporarily decrease after thunderstorms or stronger onshore winds.
- Morning conditions typically provide the clearest water.

Seagrass / Junk Grass Likelihood

- **Moderate to high**
- Late July is one of the more common periods for drifting seagrass.
- Accumulations vary significantly day-to-day depending on currents and wind direction.
- Some beaches may have little to none while others may experience noticeable accumulations.

Marine Life Expectations

- Dolphins commonly observed from:
 - HarborWalk
 - East Pass
 - Dolphin cruises
 - Okaloosa Island
- Sea turtles are present but sightings remain uncommon.
- Rays, baitfish, crabs, and shorebirds are frequently observed.

Jellyfish / Purple Flag Potential

- **Moderate**
- Purple flags are not uncommon during late July.
- Moon jellyfish and occasional stinging species may appear.
- Daily flag checks are strongly recommended.

Crowd Expectations

- **Moderately High**
- Summer vacation season remains active.
- HarborWalk, Crab Island, Boardwalk, and Baytowne are busiest during evenings and event nights.
- Beaches are busiest between 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM.

Traffic Expectations

- **Moderate to Heavy**
- US-98 congestion is common.
- Harbor Boulevard delays increase before fireworks.
- Midday and evening travel times can vary significantly.

Beach Timing Guidance

Best beach windows:

- Sunrise – 10:30 AM
- After 5:00 PM

- 11:00 AM – 4:00 PM

- Typical summer pattern:
 - Hot morning
 - Building clouds after lunch
 - Pop-up thunderstorms between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM

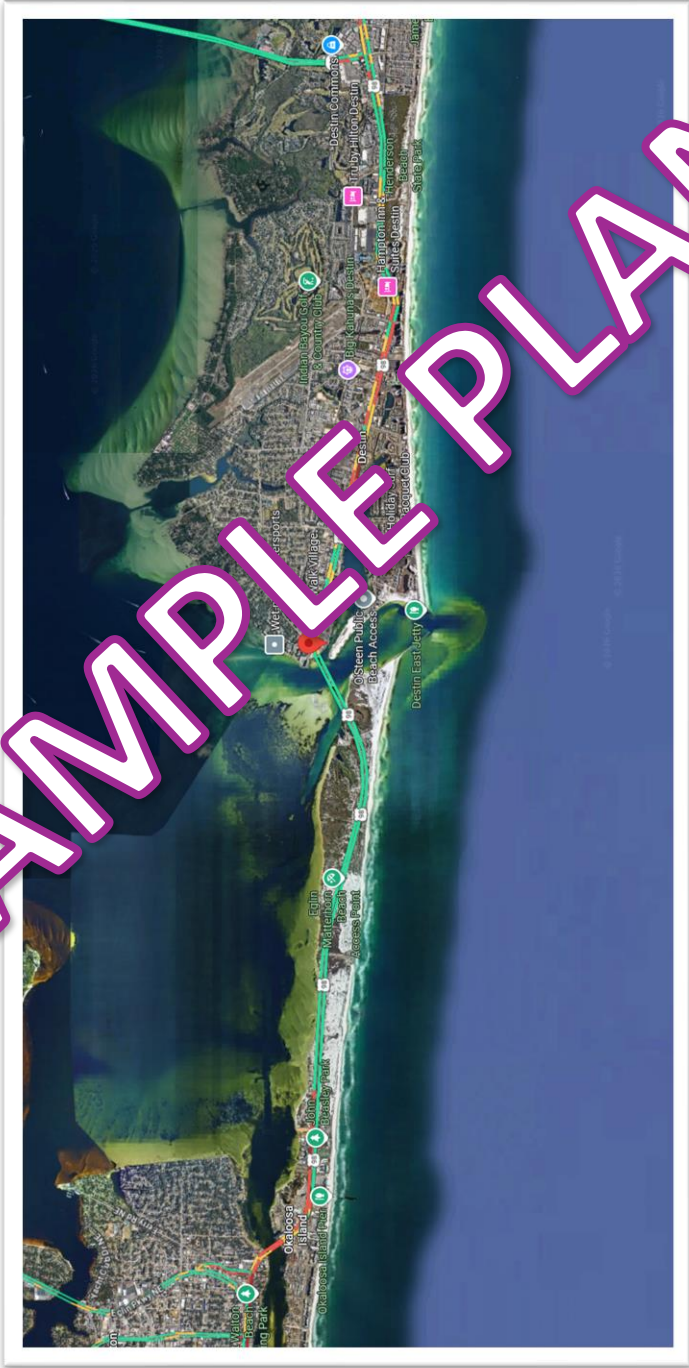
