The Mack truck spade truck had major maintenance work carried out in 2019 by a Vermeer Canada technician and is in good operational condition,. It's been inspected for 2033. There are also a number of large trees for sale on our tree farm should the new owner need large stock. We also work with Springvale Nurseries in Berwick and move some of their large trees. We have an inventory of Vermeer wire baskets and burlap liners that we can supply to the new owner as well.
