

Awards of Excellence RULES

IMPORTANT: Projects can only enter a maximum of two (2) categories. One project can only be entered once in the Presentation category and once in a Specialty category. This is to ensure that one company doesn't receive numerous awards.

One Project or property can only be entered into a maximum of two (2) categories: once in the Presentation Category <u>and</u> once in a Specialty Category.

PRESENTATION CATEGORIES

Each project / property can be entered in only ONE Presentation category

Installation:

Residential

- Under \$25K
- \$25K \$75K
- over \$75K

Commercial

- Under \$100K
- Over \$100K

Maintenance: Residential / Commercial

Design

AND ONE OF...

SPECIALTY CATEGORIES

Each project / property can be entered in only ONE Speciality category

- Environmental Stewardship
- Special Feature any one (Natural Stone, Landscape Lighting or Water Feature or Wood Construction)

General Information for the 2020 Awards of Excellence Program

- All submission materials must be submitted via email, or file sharing site (i.e. Dropbox) accompanied by the application.
- All material submitted becomes the sole property of the Landscape Nova Scotia (LNS) and may be used by LNS in whatever manner it deems appropriate. Material will not be returned.
- One project may be entered in one presentation (Installation/Construction, Maintenance or Design) Category AND one Specialty (if desired).
- The association accepts no responsibility for photographic copyright fees.
- The entry with the highest points as determined by the judges will be deemed the winner, and will be recognized in the Association's and CNLA publications and website where appropriate.
- Permission from the client must be provided.
- Judging Standards Entries can't win by default. Using the new scoring system provided by CNLA a minimum score of 75% must be achieved before any project can receive an award. This will prevent lower standard entries from winning just because they were the only.
- The 3 highest scores per category will be submitted to the National Awards of Excellence. Please notify LNS if you do not wish your entry to go to the national level.

What you must submit for the 2020 Awards of Excellence Program

- · A signed and completed entry form (found in Entry Package).
- A response to all questions (found in the Entry Package) or an explanation why of the lack of response.
- Pictures and/or video of site (before, during and after)
 - No less than 6 pictures, no more than 20.
- List of suppliers.
- Any drawings related to the project
 - All Design drawings must be provided in pdf format.
- Budgets and timelines.
- · List of materials.
- Any Specifications used for the project.
- Letter of permission from client.





An entry form is required for <u>each</u> project submitted. All information must be clearly typed or printed and emailed to Landscape NS at info@landscapenovascotia.ca.

The following information is to be included in the written brief, using these headings in this order:

- 1. A Statement of the Project Intent (75 words max.)
 - Description of the nature or complexity of the site
 - o Conditions set out by the client
 - Design theme selected to meet the client's needs

- 2. Project Description (250 words max.)
 - Overall scope:
 - a) start and completion dates;
 - b) hardiness zone;
 - c) existing site conditions
 - d) description of process, design, construction/ installation,
 - e) resolution of challenges, etc.
 - Explanation of special features: structural or specimen plantings
 - Exclusions: specify existing work that was NOT part of the design (example: if a pond was a pre-existing part of the landscape and the project was to design around the pond, indicate the pond in this exclusion section)
 - Environmental responsibility measures taken
- 3. Please include site plans if available (PDF)

Digital Images

- No less than six and no more than twenty colour images.
- Where possible, include at least one before and after image from the same perspective.
- Choose the highest quality, as these modes produce the least compression and best image quality.
- Must be submitted in .JPEG format.
- Be sure that the company name does not appear in any of the images.
