



Announcement of Satee Phuket School

Subject: Student Admissions for the International Program (Mathayomsuksa 1 and 4) and the International Program Cambridge (Year 8 and Year 10) Academic Year 2026

In order to ensure that the admission of students to Mathayomsuksa 1 and Mathayomsuksa 4 under the International Program, and Year 8 and Year 10 under the International Program Cambridge, at Satee Phuket School for the Academic Year 2026 is conducted smoothly and in full compliance with the policies and guidelines on student admissions for Academic Year 2026 issued by the Office of the Basic Education Commission (OBEC), as stipulated in Urgent Circular No. MOE 04006/43405 dated 28 August 2025, regarding policies and guidelines on student admissions under the Office of the Basic Education Commission, and Circular No. MOE 04320/9 dated 5 January 2026, concerning the announcement of policies and guidelines on student admissions under the Phangnga–Phuket–Ranong Secondary Educational Service Area Office for Academic Year 2026 in Phuket Province and Ranong Province, the school hereby announces the student admission schedule as follows:

1. Admission for Mathayomsuksa 1 / Year 8

1.1 International Program

This is a Special Program Classroom that places students at the center of learning. Instruction in all subjects is conducted in English, except for Thai Language and Thai History. The program aims to equip students with strong English communication skills for the 21st century, while ensuring a solid foundation of knowledge in accordance with the Basic Education Core Curriculum B.E. 2551 (2008).

The programs offered are as follows:

1. International Program (IP)
2. International Program Cambridge (IPC)

1) International Program: IP

Admission Requirements:

- 1) Applicants must have successfully completed Grade 6 (Prathomsuksa 6) under the Ministry of Education curriculum or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad, or be currently enrolled in Grade 6 (Prathomsuksa 6) or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad for the 2025 academic year.
- 2) There is no minimum academic performance requirement.
- 3) Applicants must demonstrate good conduct, discipline, and the ability to cooperate effectively with others.
- 4) Applicants must be in good physical health.
- 5) Parents or legal guardians must be financially prepared to support the student's educational expenses throughout the duration of the program.
- 6) The program is open to both Thai and international students.

Required Documents for Online Application Submission:

- 1) One recent 1-inch photograph of the applicant in school uniform (**JPEG file format**)
- 2) One certified true copy of the Certificate of Educational Results (Por Por 7) or the Academic Transcript (Por Por 1) (**PDF file format**)

2) International Program Cambridge: IPC

Admission Requirements:

- 1) Applicants must have successfully completed Grade 6 (Prathomsuksa 6) under the Ministry of Education curriculum, Year 7 under the Cambridge curriculum, or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad. Applicants who are currently enrolled in Grade 6 (Prathomsuksa 6), Year 7 under the Cambridge curriculum, or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad for the 2025 academic year are also eligible to apply. There is no minimum academic performance requirement.
- 2) There is no minimum academic performance requirement.
- 3) Applicants must demonstrate good conduct, discipline, and the ability to cooperate effectively with others.
- 4) Applicants must be in good physical health.
- 5) Parents or legal guardians must be financially prepared to support the student's educational expenses throughout the duration of the program.
- 6) The program is open to both Thai and international students.

1.4 Criteria for Admission Selection

1.4.1 Applicants to the International Program (IP) will be considered based on the following criteria:

1) Selection will be based on the combined results of the English test, Mathematics test, and interview, with a total score of 100 points, allocated as follows:

- English: 40 points
- Mathematics: 40 points
- Interview: 20 points

2) Applicants will be ranked based on the total score out of 100 points. In the event of a tie, consideration will be given to the scores in English, Mathematics, and the interview, respectively. If applicants remain tied in all components, selection will be determined by the order of application submission.

3) In the event that a selected applicant declines the offer, the school will offer admission to applicants on the waiting list, in order of ranking, until the announced quota is filled.

4) **All parents or legal guardians are required to sign a Learning Readiness Agreement on the documentation submission day.**

1.4.2 Applicants to the International Program Cambridge (IPC) will be considered based on the following criteria:

1) Selection will be based on the combined results of the English, Mathematics, and Science tests, together with the interview, for a total score of 100 points, allocated as follows:

- English: 25 points
- Mathematics: 25 points
- Science: 25 points
- Interview: 25 points

Applicants who are offered admission must achieve a minimum score of 50 percent in each subject.

2) Applicants will be ranked based on the total score out of 100 points. In the event of a tie, consideration will be given to the scores in English, Mathematics, Science, and the interview, respectively. If applicants remain tied in all components, selection will be determined by the order of application submission.

3) In the event that a selected applicant declines the offer, the school will offer admission to applicants on the waiting list, in order of ranking, until the announced quota is filled.

4) **All parents or legal guardians are required to sign a Learning Readiness Agreement on the document submission day.**



2. Admission for Mathayomsuksa 4 / Year 10

2.1 International Program

This Special Classroom Program is designed to foster students' positive attitudes toward learning, promote the effective use of the English language, and build confidence in using English for communication and the pursuit of global knowledge. The program also ensures that students acquire a strong foundation in accordance with the Basic Education Core Curriculum. Upon completion of Mathayomsuksa 6 or Year 13, students will be well prepared to pursue further studies at the university level, in both regular and international programs, as well as overseas institutions.

The program offers the following courses of study:

- 1) International Program (IP)
 - English–Mathematics Track
 - English–Business Track
- 2) International Program Cambridge (IPC)

Admission Requirements:

- 1) Applicants must have successfully completed Mathayomsuksa 3 (Grade 9) under the Ministry of Education curriculum or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad, or be currently enrolled in Mathayomsuksa 3 (Grade 9) or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad for the 2025 academic year.
- 2) There is no minimum academic performance requirement.
- 3) Applicants must demonstrate good conduct, discipline, and the ability to live and work harmoniously with others.
- 4) Applicants must be in good physical health.
- 5) Parents or legal guardians must be financially prepared to support the student's educational expenses throughout the duration of study.
- 6) The program is open to Thai and international students.

- 1) Applicants must have successfully completed Mathayomsuksa 3 (Grade 9) under the Ministry of Education curriculum, Year 9 under the Cambridge curriculum, or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad, or be currently enrolled in Mathayomsuksa 3 (Grade 9) or Year 9 under the Cambridge curriculum, or an equivalent program in Thailand or abroad for the 2025 academic year.
- 2) There is no minimum academic performance requirement.
- 3) Applicants must demonstrate good conduct, discipline, and the ability to live and work harmoniously with others.
- 4) Applicants must be in good physical health.
- 5) Parents or legal guardians must be financially prepared to support the student's educational expenses throughout the duration of study.
- 6) The program is open to Thai and international students.



2.4 Criteria for Admission Selection

2.4.1 Applicants to the International Program (IP), including the English–Mathematics Track and the English–Business Track, will be considered based on the following criteria:

1) Selection will be based on the combined results of the English test, Mathematics test, and interview, with a total score of 100 points, allocated as follows:

- English: 40 points
- Mathematics: 40 points
- Interview: 20 points

2) Applicants will be ranked based on the total score out of 100 points. In the event of a tie, consideration will be given to the scores in English, Mathematics, and the interview, respectively. If applicants remain tied in all components, selection will be determined by the order of application submission.

3) In the event that a selected applicant declines the offer, the school will offer admission to applicants on the waiting list, in order of ranking, until the announced quota is filled.

4) **All parents or legal guardians are required to sign a Learning Readiness Agreement on the enrollment day.**

2.4.2 Applicants to the International Program Cambridge (IPC) will be considered based on the following criteria:

1) Selection will be based on the combined results of the English, Mathematics, and Science tests, together with the interview, for a total score of 100 points, allocated as follows:

- English: 25 points
- Mathematics: 25 points
- Science: 25 points
- Interview: 25 points

Applicants who are offered admission must achieve a minimum score of 50 percent in each subject.

2) Applicants will be ranked based on the total score out of 100 points. In the event of a tie, consideration will be given to the scores in English, Mathematics, Science, and the interview, respectively. If applicants remain tied in all components, selection will be determined by the order of application submission.

3) In the event that a selected applicant declines the offer, the school will offer admission to applicants on the waiting list, in order of ranking, until the announced quota is filled.

4) **All parents or legal guardians are required to sign a Learning Readiness Agreement on the document submission day.**



3. Tuition and Fees



4. Application Procedures for Entry to Mathayomsuksa 1 and 4, Year 8 and 10

Application Procedures

1. Visit the Satee Phuket School website at www.satreephuket.ac.th.
2. Click to read the announcement titled “*Student Admissions for the International Program (Mathayomsuksa 1 and 4) and the International Program Cambridge (Year 8 and Year 10) Academic Year 2026.*”
3. Carefully review the application guidelines, step-by-step online application procedures, and instructions for completing the application form and uploading required documents.
4. Pay the examination processing fee of 200 Baht via the online application platform between 9 –13 February 2026. Applicants must retain proof of payment for verification purposes in case of any discrepancies. The examination fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
5. Select the level you wish to apply for and complete the online application process as instructed.
6. Check your application status on the school website 2 days after submission.
7. Print your examination admission card from 17 February 2026 onwards, which must be presented on the examination day.

Note: If the school finds that any submitted documents or information are false, the application will be considered null and void, and legal action may be taken.

5. Examination Guidelines for Applicants to Mathayomsuksa 1 and 4, Year 8 and 10

1. Applicants must present their examination admission card and National ID card to the invigilator before entering the examination room.
2. Candidates must prepare a pen, a 2B pencil, and an eraser. Correction fluid is not allowed.
3. Candidates are strictly prohibited from bringing communication devices, calculators, digital watches, or any documents into the examination room. All examination materials are strictly prohibited from being taken out of the examination room.
4. Only analog wristwatches are permitted for time-keeping purposes. Any form of cheating or actions suggesting cheating is strictly prohibited.
5. Candidates must sit for all examination subjects in order to be considered for selection.
6. Candidates must wear an official school uniform only.
7. Candidates are not allowed to leave the examination room unless permission is granted by the invigilator.
8. Parents are requested to drop off students at the front of the school and pick them up after the examination. Parents are not allowed to wait within the school premises.
