KHA Now Accepts Online Payments!

Kickapoo Housing Authority now accepts online payments. Please visit khakansas.org if you are interested in paying your bill online. Rent for senior units, also known as LIHTC units, can be paid by clicking the button that says KHA- LIHTC Rent Payment. All other rent can be paid by clicking the button that says KHA-Regular Rental Payment. If you are unsure about which type of unit you have, you can find out by looking at your account number on your billing statement. If your account number starts with T1, you have a LIHTC unit. If your account number starts with anything else, you have a regular rental unit.
