One of the changes the past year is our phone system. We upgraded our phone system thanks to Cares Act. When you dial the office, the option for Housing is dialing #1 and Childcare/New is #2, that leads to options to dial the Director, Occupancy, Office Manager, and Accounting or to leave a message.

The Cares Act Funding KHA received allowed us to assist with groceries and needed necessities for those in the community who needed to be quarantined. We also continued this program with the ARPA funding. If you are needing to quarantine AND have tested at the Kickapoo Clinic, please contact us for assistance. We also can provide masks and cleaning disinfectants.

KHA also received funds from the US Treasury to assist with rental obligations with an ending date of September 30, 2022. A total of \$647,846.41 was assisted with rent for eligible tribal members throughout the U.S.

KHA is appreciative of the forementioned grants that helped us during this pandemic. We encourage all to get vaccinated and boosted.

One change starting in October is administrative day for office staff. The office will be closed to the public so that staff can complete administrative duties. This will be every third Friday of the month.

Fall Maintenance/Safety Tips and Reminders

- Turn off outdoor water supply, remove and store hoses.
- Install outdoor faucet covers.
- Trim tree branches.
- Remove debris and dead vegetation.
- **Check** propane levels frequently. Levels must be kept above 33%.
- **Do Not** put small space heaters near anything flammable or in wet areas such as bathrooms.
- **Do Not** try to heat your home with your oven as this will cause the coils to burn out.
