The HGSA education committee is very proud to announce the renovations for The Owl's Roost, (formally Sunshine Cottage), have been completed and is now ready to receive students. Along with that, we are looking for dedicated teachers to serve as facilitators/instructors for the different types of classes we offer which are:

- Credit classes – required classes for HGSA certification in healing and mediumship
- Non-credit classes – part of the HGSA curriculum but not taught as part of the healing and mediumship certification programs
- Independent classes – developed and taught by individuals who want to share their knowledge/skills; can be taught in two hours or over several weeks

There are requirements to meet for each of the different types of classes and those requirements/qualifications will be emailed to you should you be interested in becoming an instructor/facilitator.

Additionally, you should know:

- Facilitators are compensated for HGSA credit and non-credit classes.

- Independents pay a fee to rent the facility and charge the students.
- Anyone interested must complete a Facilitator Application and be approved by HGSA. A class description and objective are also required to be submitted for independent classes.
- If selected, instructor/facilitator must sign a contract and follow HGSA standards.
