

ARTIST WILL NEED TO KNOW FOR YOUR NEW TATTOOS BETTER KNOW AS THE 3 “W”:

What do you want for your new tattoo:

- Clear Picture Reference for the Tattoo Artist:
 - Tattoo Artist will create the tattoo design.
- Confirm if you want a color tattoo or black and grey.
- Confirm the approximate size of the tattoo in inches.
 - Not too big or medium size does not tell the artists how small or big.
 - Size: smaller does not mean cheaper. When working with a substantial amount of detail, consider the dimensions necessary to accurately depict all elements.
- Lettering, words, or script tattoos:
 - Visit <https://dafont.com> You do not have to download the app or pay anything.
 - You can type in your word / phrase to see how it appears with each different font.
 - Once you have the font, supply the name of the font to the artist.

Where on your body do you want the tattoo:

- Body location is key to making sure the tattoo works with your body placement.
 - Please check the Tattoo Artist's portfolio, not all artists do ribs, face, necks, feet, and hands
- Tattoo Artists will need to check if tattooing over “broken out” or sunburn peeling skin.
 - If you have open acne or psoriasis or other the Tattoo Artist will need to confirm if another body location will work better not to jeopardize the quality of the tattoo.
- As we get older unfortunately so does our skin!
 - Our skin matures and when tattooed in certain areas can really be a challenge to even an experienced tattoo artist. The Tattoo Artists will confirm the area they are comfortable tattooing to ensure the best possible outcome for your new tattoo.

When do you want your new tattoo:

- If you are a tattoo walk-ins and you want the tattoo the same day it can be done.
 - Make sure you have the above figured out.
 - The sooner you come in the better chance you will have of getting your tattoo.
 - All Artists but Kal are in the shop before 12:00 PM. If you come in at 5:00 PM requesting a larger tattoo the artists will be looking at:
 - Tattoo drawing time – 1 hour.
 - Tattoo stencil to skin and drying time: 30 minutes.
 - Tattoo time: 3 or more hours.

It can be done but you have a better chance of getting your tattoo if you come in early!
