benefits:

Kittens: 16 weeks and older

Puppies: 16 weeks and older

Females

Eliminates the constant crying and nervous pacing
of female cats; the messiness of female dog heat
cycle.

Eliminates life threatening infections of the uterus
(Pyometra) and virtually eliminates mammary and
ovarian cancers.

Eliminates pregnancy - 100%

Males

Decreases urine marking, aggressiveness, humping,
and urge to roam.

Male cats and dogs, especially if fixed before sexual
maturity, tend to be less aggressive and more
affectionate.
