ORDINANCE NO. SEPTEMBER 8, 1982

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLCREEK,
LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON, UPON, OR ALONG
THE NORTH SIDE OF MAIN STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Millcreek, County of Lebanon, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that henceforth the parking of vehicles on, upon, or along the north side of Main Street in the Village of Newmanstown, from a point of beginning at the Railroad Bridge at the East end of said street to a point of ending at the Millcreek Bridge at the West end of said street, is prohibited at all times. The word "vehicle" as used herein shall have the same meaning as it has in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code. "No Parking" signs shall be erected in accordance with the law throughout said area. Any person who violates this ordinance shall pay a fine of Five (5.00) Dollars for each offense. Each continuation of a violation beyond twelve hours shall be deemed and shall be taken to be a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.
