COACHES CODE OF ETHICS

I hereby pledge to live up to my coaches certification and to the code of ethics set forth by the SAF.

- I will lead by example both on and off the field demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all players.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win. Injured players will be removed from all practices and/or games whose health is questionable.
- I will be a transformational coach, focusing on coaching the entire child, not just athleticism.
I will utilize the InsideOut Coaching book to help create a consistent and intentional coaching style.
- I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range of emotional and physical development for the same age group.
- I will reinforce the importance of scholastic as well as athletic achievements.
- I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.
- I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
- I will be knowledgeable and abide by both the River Valley YFL and IHSA rules and regulations at all times.
I will teach these rules to my players.
- I will purposefully and intentionally coach using the F.I.G.H.T Virtues [Faith - Integrity - Generosity - Humility - Trust]
- I will make certain that all players are given an opportunity to play the required minimum number of plays according to the River Valley game rules.
- I will not run-up the score on a weaker opponent.
- I will provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use during all practices, games and any other team events.
- I will remember that I am a youth football coach, and that the game is for the **children** and **not adults**.
- I will not berate or criticize game officials and will accept their decision as fair. I will not berate a player at anytime.
- I will not involve any children or adults in any dispute or complaint that do not directly involve them personally (i.e., team meetings, phone calls, etc.) to discuss disputes or complaints.
- I will not incite fans or spectators into actions unbecoming the game of football.
- I will abide by any decision of the Executive Directors concerning any matters related to the RVYFL or its guidelines and procedures.
- I will treat opposing teams, coaches, volunteers, and referees with the utmost respect at all times.
- Any disputes between members of a coaching staff shall be handled in private, away from children and spectators. **Public outburst will not be tolerated!** Disputes of any kind shall be handled in a calm adult manner.

I agree to abide by all the SAF Coaches Code of Ethics as set forth herein and as amended from time to time. I understand that failure to follow the Code of Ethics may result in my immediate removal, suspension or other actions deemed appropriate by the St Ann Football Leadership Team.
