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Purpose

The purpose of this Parent / Guest Code of Conduct for our youth football organization is to foster a positive and respectful environment, promoting sportsmanship, fair play, and the overall well-being of our young athletes. By adhering to these guidelines, parents contribute to the development of a supportive community that prioritizes the physical, emotional, and social growth of our youth, ensuring an enriching and enjoyable football experience for all involved. This code of conduct will also be guided by the league's code of conduct policy.

Roles and Responsibilities

The Director of Policy is responsible for the content and compliance of this policy.

The advisory council is responsible for reviewing and approving this policy at least annually to ensure it continues to encourage and maintain a positive atmosphere for our young athletes.

Proper Conduct for Parents and Guests

Supportive Atmosphere

Encourage a positive and supportive environment for all players, coaches, officials, and fellow parents.

Respect for All

Treat everyone with respect, including players, coaches, officials, and opposing teams. Avoid negative comments or actions.

Sportsmanship

Promote good sportsmanship and fair play. Applaud good plays from both teams.

Communication Channels

Utilize appropriate communication channels for addressing concerns or issues. Direct communication with coaches is encouraged.

Player Development

Encourage your child's development and growth, both as an athlete and an individual. Celebrate their achievements and efforts.

Attendance

Ensure that your child attends practices and games regularly and arrives on time. Notify coaches in advance of any conflicts.

Equipment Care

Ensure that your child's equipment is well-maintained and in good condition.

Positive Role Model

Be a positive role model for your child by demonstrating good sportsmanship and respectful behavior. No smoking, drinking or drug use will be tolerated at St. Ann Golden Eagle events. Please refrain from using foul language.

Violation of the Parent / Guest Code of Conduct

Any organizational stakeholder may request a review of a Violation of the Code of Conduct by completing the necessary form. The form will be submitted to the Director of Policy for review and preliminary ruling.

A violation of this code of conduct will be ruled on by the Director of Policy. The Director of Policy will send a record of violation to the football council for review. If the football council rules a violation of the Parent / Guest code of conduct has occurred, the football council will send notice to the Quality Control sub-council for review and/or action.

Disciplinary Action

The Quality Control sub-council will review all code of conduct violations and recommend necessary and appropriate disciplinary actions to the football council. The following guidelines may be used however more serious violations will be acted upon swiftly and appropriately.

Verbal Warning

Initial violation may result in a verbal warning from coaches or organization officials.

Written Warning

Persistent or more serious violations may lead to a written warning outlining the issue and expected behavior.

Probation

Continued rule violations may result in a probationary period with specific conditions for improvement.

Suspension

In cases of severe or repeated misconduct, suspension from participation may be implemented.

Expulsion

For egregious or continued violations, expulsion from the organization may be considered. An expulsion from the organization involving a parent may also include the necessity to remove the child for the safety and well-being of athletes involved.

These codes of conduct and policies are designed to foster a positive, respectful, and inclusive environment within the St. Ann Golden Eagles Youth Football and Cheer Organization. St. Ann Golden Eagles Youth Football and Cheer will abide by any code of conduct actions recommended and/or approved by the league's Board.
