## From Fr. Ron

Trinity Sunday celebrates one God, three persons, complete mystery. And the readings this week ground us in the simplicity of who God is and what God does for us.

The story of Moses on the mountain reveals a God who meets us on the mountains of our lives, who reveals his mercy and love, faithfulness and patience. When we ask God for what we need, he answers, even if his answers aren't as immediate or clear as the stone tablets. In the fullness of time, this same God reveals the plan for our salvation: Jesus is sent in human flesh to love us. By his life, death and rising, Jesus give us the example of how to love and then gives us the gift of the Spirit.

So much of our spiritual life is participation in a mystery that is beyond our understanding, but the second reading offers us a simple guide and blessing. Live the moments of your life seeking peace with God and one another, and allow the healing grace of Jesus, the love of the Father, and the communion of the Spirit to be poured over you and everything you do.

May it be enough for us to live right in the middle of this mystery of God working love in and through our lives. May the Father, Son and Holy Spirit flow through us to those most in need of God's simple and saving love.

### CEMETERY CROSS & CORPUS

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. However, due to a decrease in sales of cemetery plots, the cemetery does not have the funds to cover the cost of the cross and corpus.

We are looking to raise funds to help cover this expense so that you will have a beautiful place to pray or meditate while visiting your loved ones.

Material costs are \$12,810. Installation costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480.

As a side note, the Catholic Church teaches us that due to the dignity of the human person, it is ok to have a loved one remain cremated, but those ashes should be buried. They are not to be kept or spread out over an area.

### My Dear Friends in Christ:

We can take comfort in the words of the Holy Father during these challenging times, "We have a hope: by his cross we have been healed and embraced so that nothing and no one can separate us from His redeeming love."

There are so many that deserve our thanks during this crisis. Thank you to every health-care worker and all frontline workers (pharmacy, grocery, take-out, gasoline, etc.) for your service!

Our parishes, priests and parish laity are praying intensely for us during this time of crisis and are all working hard to help. Let us continue to pray and fully support them as much as we can. 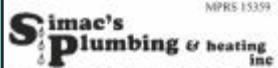
