

#### **CEMETERY CROSS & CORPUS**

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. However, due to a decrease in sales of cemetery plots, the cemetery does not have the funds to cover the cost of the cross and corpus.

We are looking to raise funds to help cover this expense so that you will have a beautiful place to pray or meditate while visiting your loved ones.

Material costs are \$12,810. Installation costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480.

As a side note, the Catholic Church teaches us that due to the dignity of the human person, it is ok to have a loved ones remains cremated, but those ashes should be buried. They are not to be kept or spread out over an area.






