

From Deacon Rick



Well, we gathered last weekend here at St. Peter's, and as expected, attendance was modest but hopeful, given the situation in which we find ourselves. Folks will be gathering at St. Mary's and St. Albert's this weekend according to the plans for those parishes. We understand there are many who are not yet comfortable with large groups. The bishop has acknowledged this reality and reminds everyone of the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass; and for this year, the

obligation for the annual "Easter duty" of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and reception of Holy Communion at least once during the season had also been dispensed. Your cooperation in wearing a mask, sanitizing your hands, following the directions of our ministers of hospitality are greatly appreciated.

Perhaps it is providential that as we're all finding our way through this pandemic and returning to our church homes, that we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord, or Corpus Christi. Researchers into Catholic belief and practice tell us that less than half of Catholics actually believe what the Church holds as truth regarding the Body and Blood of Jesus: that at the words of consecration, the bread and wine, while maintaining the appearance of bread and wine, actually become the Body and Blood of Jesus. Not a symbol or representation, not a momentary transformation, but always and forever the Body and Blood of our Lord. We've experienced a fast from this sacred gift for many weeks. Many have longed to return to church in order to partake of Holy Communion.

And while this longing is laudable, I have to say I have longed to more fully BE the Body of Christ, something from which we've also been fasting – our coming together, physically, in the same space. And while our physical coming together will look and feel very different for a while, I hope each of you will take the priest or deacon's final command, and go out and be for others the gift we each are privileged to receive.





CEMETERY CROSS & CORPUS

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. However, due to a decrease in sales of cemetery plots, the cemetery does not have the funds to cover the cost of the cross and corpus.

Material costs are \$12,810. Installation costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480. Total estimated replacement is \$21,290.

New REQUIREMENTS at Mass:

- Exit after communion with no social gathering
