Reflection

“Those who are just must be kind,” says today’s first reading. If our words and deeds are kind and selfless, we will be like the good seed in the Gospel parable and gathered as wheat in the Lord’s harvest.

Formation Question

Adult: What weakness can the power of the Spirit help you overcome?

Child: When will you need the help of the Holy Spirit this week?

FROM FR. RICH

Parables...

Throughout the three years our Lord gathered together his disciples and went about the countryside teaching about the Kingdom of God, he taught using parables. One definition of a parable is, “a short allegorical story designed to teach some truth, religious principle, or moral lesson” usually using a ‘comparison’ between two things for illustration. Why did Jesus use “parables” to teach about the Kingdom of God? Most of the people Jesus encountered, except for the Scribes, Pharisees, Sadducees, and some in other positions of authority, couldn’t read or write. By using these short stories Jesus could make an illustrative point, by using language and imagery the people knew, that could be taken away and pondered over. There are seven parables concerning the kingdom present in the Church and this weekend we hear about three of them.

We also heard that Jesus privately instructed his closest companions on the meaning of the parables. Jesus is setting the foundation for His Church, that it will be arranged hierarchically, and he will give His authority to the apostles who through succession will administer the sacraments. His small band of disciples will grow into a worldwide faith-based community of believers. These same believers will spread the Good News across the world that will eventually come to know that the Cross, Jesus’ Cross, would become the sign and symbol representing Christianity; the undisputable mark of our faith.

Whether comparing weeds and wheat, a small mustard seed that could grow into a ten-foot tree, or the recipe for leavened bread, Jesus is teaching all that listened about the kingdom of heaven; where good overcomes evil, light shatters darkness, sin is washed away by the mercy and love of God and death is conquered once and for all by new life.

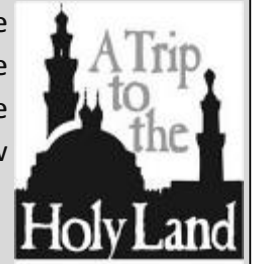

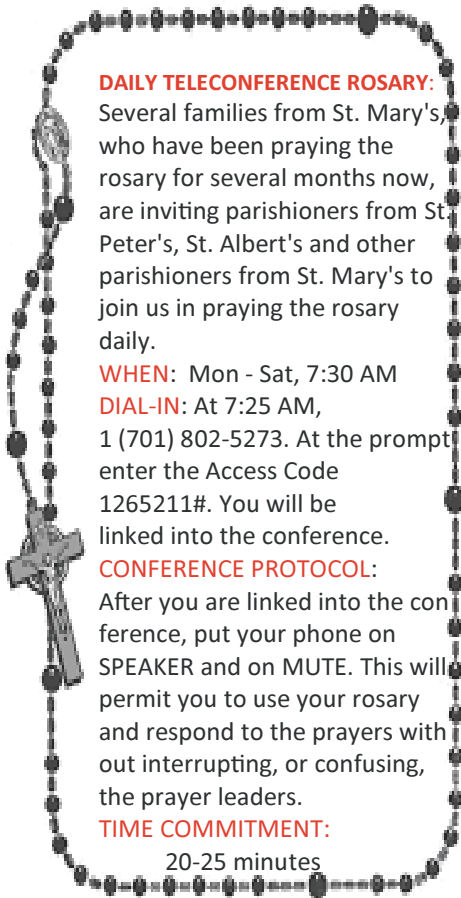

CEMETERY CROSS & CORPUS

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. However, due to a decrease in sales of cemetery plots, the cemetery does not have the funds to cover the cost of the cross and corpus.

Material costs are \$12,810. Installation costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480. Total estimated replacement is \$21,290.
