

### Reflection

Elijah recognized the voice of God

not in the strong and heavy wind, not in the earthquake, and not in the fire, but in a tiny whispering sound. May we find enough quiet in our clamorous world to hear His voice and discern what He is calling us to do and be.

Formation Question

Adult: When have you doubted the

loving care of God for you as the apostles did in the boat?

Child: How do you know that Jesus is with you at all times?

#### FROM FR. RON

In the gospel readings this month Jesus is no longer teaching the crowds; he continues his ministry of healing, but reserves his words for the group of his close followers. In each of the passages we read this month, Jesus shows who he is, and the first reading each Sunday helps bring that showing to the fore.

Isaiah had promised an eschatological banquet that would recreate Israel once and for all, on the model of the feeding of God's people in the desert; Jesus feeds the multitudes in a deserted place, with words that echo both the Jewish meal blessing and the Eucharist to come. Elijah recognizes the passing of God in the still silence after the storms; Jesus is recognized in the stillness that comes after he has conquered the waves and the winds. Isaiah had promised that God's reign would extend to all nations; Jesus welcomes the Canaanite woman into the community of believers. God appoints a new steward over King David's household; Jesus appoints a new steward, Peter, over his renewed household of faith.

We have all taken steps out in faith. In scary moments, when we are faced with a life-changing, faith-testing decision – the new job, the new relationship, the new life path – faith in God is all we have. Our faith emboldens us to call out to the One who says, "Take heart, it is I; do not be afraid." Things might not always turn out the way we want them to, but God remains with us to see us through it.

In today's liturgy, we celebrate God's promise of presence, in each other, in the Word, in the sacrament and in the world we are called to serve. Let us give thanks for God's presence and for our calling, as we step forth in faith to answer that call.

#### **CEMETERY CROSS & CORPUS**

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. However, due to a decrease in sales of cemetery plots, the cemetery does not have the funds to cover the cost of the cross and corpus.

Material costs are \$12,810. Installation

costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480. Total estimated replacement is \$21,290.

#### **NEW MISSALS**






