Reflection In today's second reading, St. Paul tells the Romans, "God's gifts and his call are irrevocable." To what is God calling me today? What gifts are mine to share?

Formation Question
Adult: The woman in this story was persistent in prayer. For what do you pray insistently?
Child: For what do you ask God to give you most often?

FROM FR. RICH

The Canaanite woman whose daughter was tormented by a devil came to Christ begging his help. By perseverance she became worthy; for Christ not only admitted her to the same noble rank as the children, but he also sent her away with high praise, saying: "Woman, you have great faith. Let it be as you desire."

Now when Christ says: "You have great faith," you need seek no further proof of the woman's greatness of soul. You see that this woman became worthy by perseverance.

When the woman herself, still crying out, came to him and said, "that is true, sir, and yet the dogs eat what falls from their master's table," then he granted her request, saying, "let it be as you desire."

And at the beginning, when she first made her request, he did not answer, but after she had come to him once, twice, and a third time, he gave her what she desired. By this he was teaching us that he had withheld the gift not to drive her away, but to make that woman's patience an example for all of us.

Now that we have learned these lessons, let us not despair even if we are guilty of sin and unworthy of any favor. We know that we can make ourselves worthy by perseverance."

Homily on Phil 1:18, 12-13: Bareille 5,495-496 - St. John Chrysostom

We can all grow in patience and perseverance. These are things that we should pray for every day; I know easier said than done. All prayers are answered, always, not in our time or the way we may want, but in God's time and by His will. It was the Lord's will to answer the women's prayer. Have patience and persevere not only in prayer but all aspects of your life; I'm sure that is what our Lord wants; thy will be done.

CEMETERY CROSS & CORPUS

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. Material costs are \$12,810. Installation costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480. Total estimated replacement is \$21,290.

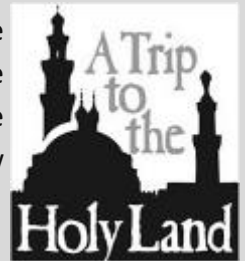

NEW MISSALS

With the beginning of Advent comes the start of the new Liturgical Year. It also means new missals. This year we have decided to switch over to **3-year cycle missals**. This means that the new missals won't have to be changed every year. These are more expensive, but will only have to be replaced when they get worn.

Our total cost of all books, accompaniments and shipping total \$12,600. The cost per book comes to approximately \$21.
