

Reflection

In today's readings, St. Paul reminds the

Romans- and us-

that all things come from God: "For from Him and through Him and for Him all things are." Good stewards understand that all is gift and share generously the gifts of time, talent, and treasure with which they've been blessed.

Formation Question

Adult: If you were asked, how would you explain Jesus to a person who had not heard of him?

Child: Who do you tell people Jesus is?

FROM FR. RON

In today's Gospel Jesus questions his disciples: "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" and "Who do you say that I am?" Peter's quick reply to the latter was, "You are the Christ." Did he know what he was saying? I'm not sure. In the same situation, I would have been at a loss for an answer. Now, two thousand years later, I ponder that second question and I can come up with varied answers. Jesus said, "I am the good shepherd... I am the gate... I am the light... I am the true vine."

A retreat I attended some years ago was based on this scripture passage and provided me with a new perspective. We spent our time for meditation and prayer focusing on reverse questioning: Who am I? How do I see myself? How do I want Jesus to see me?

Reflecting on my relationship with Jesus offered me new insights and a heartfelt desire to follow him more closely. I often take for granted the fact that he is a constant in my life – always present to me, whether or not I acknowledge him. Today's psalm proclaims, "I give you thanks, O Lord, with my whole heart... your steadfast love endures forever." How blessed are we!

Jesus chose Peter. The main reason could not be Peter's character of his strength, but the strength of his faith. Deep down he knew himself to be weak and imperfect, hence he was convinced that his total security and strength could only come from a power greater than his own. Peter's story illustrates how the Lord entrusted the Church He founded in the hands of

imperfect humans. The history of the Church buffeted by internal dissent and confusion from the early centuries right down to our own times, has proven Christ's words: "And the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Mt 16:18).

CEMETERY CROSS & CORPUS

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. Material costs are \$12,810. Installation costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480. Total estimated replacement is \$21,290.
