

FROM DEACON RICK

"Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." Crosses! They've become a benign part of our life. We wear them as jewelry around our necks, on our lapels. Tattoos of various kinds of crosses can be seen adorning the human body. They hang on our walls, they hang from our rear-view mirrors. They have become ubiquitous . . . and often heavily sanitized of their origins through our domestication of them. So the words we read today don't have the same sting, don't evoke the same reaction as they likely did when they were written. The evangelist Matthew had a reason for this episode in his gospel, because the people of his time were being persecuted, even enduring crucifixion. Matthew wanted his community to know that this was part and parcel of what they signed on for.

If I were a betting man, I'd wager on none of us literally having to take up the cross. And yet, the words "take up his cross and follow me" are spoken directly to each one of us. Our crosses may be different, but our reaction, if we consider ourselves disciples, is to embrace them, to accept them. We are to be examples to others in how we live out our discipleship.

On a personal note, when you read this, I will officially have retired as Pastoral Associate, my paid position at St. Peter's. It's been just short of eight years that I have had the blessing and privilege of serving you in that role and as your deacon. While I won't be in the office on a daily basis any longer, I will continue to serve the parish as deacon. Kathy and I have no plans to go anywhere. I hope and pray, like the first rule of camping, that in my time here I've left the place a little better off than when I got here. I do want you to remember a couple of things. Changes have come to this part of the diocese. We are now part of a 5 parish cluster. Staff roles and relationships are changing, and there will likely be increasing levels of cooperation among the parishes and parish staffs. Be flexible and patient as these new roles and relationships "shake out." And finally, learn to be comfortable with change. If I were a betting man, I'd say there will be more to come.

If you have been out to the St. Peter's Cemetery since last summer, you may have noticed that the cross and corpus have been taken down from the altar. Both pieces have been cracking and crumbling for many years, however, they are no longer "fixable". So, to prevent any injuries, they were taken down.

A big thank you to Tom Busha for researching a replacement for us. Material costs are \$12,810. Installation costs are \$8,000 (unless someone is willing to help us out) and freight to Eagle River from Chicago Customs is \$480. Total estimated replacement is \$21,290.


Volunteer Opportunities


