FROM FR. RON

It's just not fair! Like children who bemoan being denied something that has been afforded another, we all intermittently rail against God for not getting our just deserts. Why did this faithful, God-loving and generous person get struck with cancer, lose a job or get rear-ended in traffic while another who appears completely arrogant, inconsiderate and selfabsorbed is spared life's misfortunes?

Like the laborers in the vineyard, we challenge God about the perceived inequity of our situation. It's hard to accept that living a long life of loving and faithful service can net the same eternal reward as an eleventh-hour conversion and repentance that follows a lifetime of depravity. It's like a get-into-heaven-free card who previously had not demonstrated a smidgen of love, compassion or care for God or neighbor.

We think and judge with the limited human understanding provided us. God sees all and judges with infinite knowledge. The get-into-heaven-free card can only be played if the holder has had a true conversion and comes to know Jesus personally as their Savior. We ought to rejoice that God's infinite compassion and forgiveness can offer us the eternal reward promised for a life well-lived instead of fretting that someone else may not have merited the same benefit.

Let us bear this in mind that for God all services of love whether they are big or small are important and accounted for in His eyes.

And because God is so generous so we have to be very grateful to Him. God is so kind and so we have to be thankful to Him. If God is only just, then all of us will end up outside God's kingdom.

ST. PETER'S NEW MISSALS

With the beginning of Advent comes the start of the new Liturgical Year. It also means new missals. This year St. Peter's has decided to switch over to **3-year cycle missals**. This means that the new missals won't have to be changed every year. These are more expensive, but will only have to be replaced when they get worn.



If you are interested in "donating" a missal, a sticker will be put in the inside-front cover of the book stating that "This book was generously donated by …". Our total cost of all books, accompaniments and shipping total \$12,600. The cost per book comes to approximately \$21. If this is something you would be interested in doing, please send in your "purchase price" with a memo stating St. Peter Missal Contribution. A sticker will be printed for every missal you "purchase". Then you can play musical chairs at St. Peter's to find your book!




