## FROM DEACON RICK

The readings we encounter today have a common theme: personal responsibility and ongoing conversion of mind and heart. Both of these actually mean something in the lives of Christians, in the lives of Catholics. One of the ways we are challenged in our personal responsibility as Catholics is the way in which we encounter life in the public sector, most notably in how we vote. In the past weeks, and no doubt in the coming weeks, you've heard or you will hear about how you're supposed to vote "as a Catholic." There have been some who have suggested that it is a sin to vote for one or the other candidate or party, or that you "can't be Catholic" and vote for a particular candidate or party. In reality, the Church leaves the decision for whom to vote to you and your individual conscience, with one qualification.

Regardless of what you may have heard, officially, the Catholic Church should and does only counsel you on how to develop an "informed conscience." It is your personal responsibility, in the eyes of the Church, to invest the time in knowing what the Church teaches and why, toward the formation of an informed conscience.

To that end, the bishops of the United States, the USCCB, issues a booklet every 4 years, intended to help Catholic Christian voters form their consciences and thus meet their personal responsibility. Sadly, many Catholics simply blow with the winds of a political preference and have never read the bishops' document, **Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship: A Call to Political Responsibility from the Catholic Bishops of the United States.**

If you've taken the time, if you've exercised your personal responsibility, and digested the information in **Forming Consciences**, then with an informed conscience you can exercise your right and duty to vote and be secure in that choice, whatever it might be.



This means that the new missals won't have to be changed every year. These are more expensive, but will only have to be replaced when they get worn.

Our total cost of all books, accompaniments and shipping total \$12,600. The cost per book comes to approximately \$21. 


