

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

### **VETERINARY CARE & HEALTH PROTOCOL**

#### **Mythical Dream Maine Coon Cattery**

All kittens born and raised at Mythical Dream Maine Coon Cattery follow a structured veterinary protocol prior to placement. This information is provided to ensure full transparency regarding health care.

#### **VETERINARY EXAMINATIONS**

Each kitten is examined by a licensed veterinarian at:

- 8 weeks of age
- 12 weeks of age

Each appointment includes a full clinical assessment.

#### **FULL PHYSICAL EXAMINATION INCLUDES**

- Eyes, ears, nose, and throat
- Oral cavity (teeth, gums, mucous membranes)
- Heart rate and rhythm
- Lung sounds
- Abdomen and gastrointestinal function
- Urogenital system
- Musculoskeletal structure and limb development
- Neurological response and reflexes
- Lymph nodes
- Skin and coat condition

#### **VACCINATIONS**

- FVRCP vaccination at 8 weeks
- FVRCP vaccination at 12 weeks

Further vaccinations are covered under paragraph 8, page 5 of the contract under Buyer's Obligations:

“8. Kittens will have been given core vaccinations at 8 weeks and again at 12 weeks. Future vaccines will be left to the discretion of the Buyer and their veterinarian. Mythical Dream recommends having a veterinarian perform titre testing for core vaccination immunity levels prior to receiving a booster. If immunity levels are acceptable, then no booster shall be given. This is to prevent the over-vaccination of companion animals. Vaccine related illnesses are not covered under the guarantee. Vaccinations are never without risk. Please have an open discussion with your veterinarian about this. Please note that the FIP vaccination automatically voids ANY form of health guarantee.”

### **PARASITE CONTROL**

Kittens follow an age-appropriate deworming and parasite prevention protocol prior to placement. This is completed by the Breeder and documented in the vaccination record and outlined in the contract under paragraph 2, page 3 (Seller’s Obligations):

“2. The Seller will have completed age-appropriate vaccinations, these services are provided by a licensed veterinarian. Deworming and preventative flea/tick treatment are provided by the breeder and are noted as such in the vaccination booklet.”

### **MICROCHIPPING**

All kittens are microchipped at the 12-week veterinary visit, as outlined in the contract under paragraph 3, page 3 (Seller’s Obligations):

“3. Kitten(s)/cat(s) will be microchipped prior to leaving.”

### **VETERINARY DOCUMENTATION**

Each kitten goes home with:

- A Veterinary Certificate of Health, signed by the attending veterinarian

An email is sent directly to the veterinary clinic authorizing the release of the kitten’s medical records to the new owner, or their designated veterinary representative.

### **CLIENT COMMUNICATION**

Clients are notified following each veterinary appointment.

**All veterinary care is completed and documented prior to placement.**
