

# Coins for Kids—Getting Started

## Make a Plan

Make a plan to introduce this year's project to your girls. Use any of the available products and resources so your girls can get involved right away. Provide each girl with a **Coins for Kids Promo Card** and play the promotional video during your time together.



## Set a Goal


Challenge the girls to set a giving goal for the year. Provide a time for your girls to pray and ask God what He would have them do in response to the need presented with the 2026 project. You might be surprised by what they will give! Use the *Faith Promise Cards* and the *Coins for Kids Goal Coloring Page* for girls to write out their goals. Remember, these are amounts that will exercise their faith in giving, not just what they have to give.

## Get Started

Set aside a time each week, month, or quarter to collect the offering from your girls. As your girls begin to give, celebrate with them by presenting each girl with a *Coins for Kids Giving Certificate*.

# Create-Your-Own Bible Bag

## Materials Needed for Each Bible Bag

- White tote bag
- Fabric markers
- Sharpies
- Puff paint
- Paint brushes

You can order bulk white tote bags on Amazon.

## Directions

1. Hand out one white tote bag per student.
2. Open all the supplies and lay them on the table.
3. Decorate the bags.
4. Allow the bags to dry.
5. Use the bag to carry your Bible!

When you use your bag to carry your Bible, remember all the amazing women in the Bible and how God used them. Let your bag remind you that God has a special plan for you and that spending time with Him is important. As you carry your Bible bag, remember that God wants you to share His love with others. One way you can do this is by praying for the girls who will be part of the Convoy of Hope's Girls' Empowerment program.



# For Such a Time as This

## What Is the Event Theme and How Do You Use It?

Every year, National Girls Ministries releases an *Nationalwide Event Planning Guide* to give you intentional, focused material that is designed to strengthen and minister to girls, with a special emphasis on missions.

These materials includes devotions, activities, and discipleship material to use in a variety of ways.

This event can be scheduled on any date that is most convenient for your church or district. For elementary-age girls, it's a great way to launch the year and invite guests to church. The event is designed for any church to use as a girls-only event. It's a great tool for outreach to the community!

The 2026 Girls Ministries Nationwide Event theme is *For Such a Time as This*.

During the event, girls will experience a woodsy, storybook theme and learn about different women in the Bible. They will explore what we can learn from the lives and experiences of these biblical women.

Girls will also learn about our BGMC missions project, Convoy of Hope's Girls' Empowerment program. The goal of Convoy of Hope is to provide resources needed to help empower women and children. The girls will focus on helping to equip women overseas with resources they need to get an education.



# Fundraising Ideas

## January: Winter Warm-Up Bake Sale

Have the girls make and sell homemade cookies, hot chocolate, and muffins. For a fun twist, the girls could have a decorating station where people can decorate their own cookies for an extra donation.

## February: Valentine's Day Flower & Card Sale

In class, create homemade cards for the girls to sell before Valentine's Day. At church, sell flowers and the homemade cards. Girls can even ask their friends and neighbors and ask them to purchase a card and flower for missions.

## March: Spring Family Scavenger Hunt

Organize a church scavenger hunt and sell tickets before the day. Include simple prizes for winners. You can have mini games that families have to complete to move on to the next station. Or, do a photo scavenger hunt and have them text in photos with different spots around your church. Have fun and see what fits best for your church.

## April: Painting Party

Purchase some paint supplies and sell tickets for individuals to be part of a painting party. Their ticket price includes all the basic paint supplies needed and some light refreshments. If you have a local artist who would be willing to host a painting class, invite them to come and everyone can make the same painting. Or you can have individuals paint their own creations.

## May: Mother's Day Tea

Host a Mother's Day Tea the Saturday before Mother's Day. Allow the kids to take part and create table centerpieces or crafts to give to their mom or another woman in the church during the tea. You can also have some special mother/daughter activities for families to do together.

## June: Summer Carnival

Host a mini-summer carnival and sell tickets for each activity. You can have different games, food items, a silent auction, face painting, etc.

## July: Red, White, and Blue Family Fun Run

Create a mile run/walk course for families to do. They can participate by giving a donation towards BGMC. Families can come dressed in red, white, and blue. Offer some fun prizes for best outfits, or team spirit. At the end of the fun run, hand out red, white, and blue freeze pops!

## August: Decorate-Your-Backpack Day

Have kids bring in a donation for BGMC, and they can use some fun supplies to decorate their backpacks. Provide fabric markers, rhinestones or sticky gems, iron-on patches, and keychain-making stations.

## September: After-Church Cookout

After church, host a cookout with burgers, hot dogs, chips, and water. Donations can be made to BGMC, and then people can enjoy lunch together. For fun, you can offer outdoor games for families to play.

## October: Pumpkin-Painting Night

Purchase some paint supplies, and mini pumpkins. Sell tickets for individuals to be part of a pumpkin-painting party. Their ticket price includes all the basic paint supplies needed, a pumpkin, and some light refreshments. Who can create the best pumpkin?

## November: Thanksgiving Pie Sale

Sell homemade pies for Thanksgiving. You can have pie options available at the start of the month on an order form and kids can take pie orders. You could also host a pie bake sale.

## December: Christmas Ornaments

Have the girls make and sell homemade ornaments.
