Babolat RPM Blast (black)	1.25 mm	<p>(\$5 additional charge)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High-spin string designed for aggressive, modern topspin players • Octagonal (8-sided) shape helps grip the ball for enhanced spin generation • Firm feel provides excellent control on big swings • Best for intermediate to advanced players (can feel stiff for beginners) • Works well in hybrid setups
Diadem Solstice Power (light blue)	1.25 mm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Best for maximum spin and comfort, softer and more elastic than Hyper-G • Six-pointed star shape that bites the ball extremely well • Top tier spin (arguably more than Hyper-G), slightly less control and durability • More power and comfort
Kirschbaum Max Power (black)	1.20 mm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Best for big hitters who want firmness • Firmest and most control oriented string (not ideal for most players) • Best only if you want a stiff, dead poly for maximum directional control
Kirschbaum Pro Line II (black)	1.20 mm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Best for comfort among thin polys • Soft, lively, and easy to swing with • Good comfort and pocketing • More power, less control
Luxilon ALU Power Soft (dark gray)	1.20 mm	<p>(\$5 additional charge)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Softer, more arm-friendly variant of the iconic ALU Power polyester string (one of the top polyester strings on the tour ideal for advanced players for combination of explosive power and control) • Control and precision of ALU Power but with a slightly more forgiving feel, signature tour-level response while reducing harshness on impact
Solinco Hyper-G (bright green)	1.25 mm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Best overall for modern baseline play • Most balanced mix of spin and control on full swings, elite spin from square profile • Firm but not harsh, great for aggressive players, stable response at lower tensions • Works well in hybrid setups • If you hit heavy topspin or like taking big cuts, this is the most complete option
Yonex Polytour Pro (blue)	1.20 mm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smooth, low powered, very comfortable poly, best for comfort and consistency • Excellent tension stability • Predictable response, not as much spin or bite as shaped strings • Ideal for players who value feel and arm friendliness

Kirschbaum (black)	1.30 mm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Excellent balance of comfort, power, durability and spin • Solid core wrapped with flexible filaments for enhanced playability and comfort • Ideal for players seeking all-around performance and perfect for hybrid setups with Kirschbaum Pro Line • Great for beginners, recreational players, and anyone who wants a dependable, easy-playing setup

Tecnifibre X-One Biphase (natural)	1.25 mm	<p>(\$5 additional charge)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Premium multifilament string known for its exceptional comfort and feel • High power level, making it easy to generate depth with less effort • “Biphase” construction process increases durability and resilience • Soft, arm-friendly response, closest synthetic alternative to natural gut • Great for intermediate to advanced players for comfort and performance • Works well in hybrid setups
Wilson NXT (natural)	1.25 mm	<p>(\$5 additional charge)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One of the most popular multifilament tennis strings • Designed to mimic the comfort and power of natural gut while remaining more durable and affordable • Ideal for players who want maximum comfort, feel, and a larger sweet spot without switching to natural gut
