Community-Funded Portrait Experiences

Every child and family deserves the opportunity to be seen, celebrated, and beautifully photographed. Portraits of Promise partners with nonprofits, hospitals, shelters, adoption and family-service organizations, churches, schools, and sponsors to make meaningful professional portrait experiences accessible to the communities they serve.

PORTRAIT PROGRAM FEES

Promise Mini	Up to 10 children / families	\$1,000
Community Day	Up to 15 children / families	\$1,500
Community Day Plus	Up to 25 children / families	\$2,250
Promise Impact Day	Up to 40 children / families	\$3,250
Larger / Specialized Programs	40+ participants, hospitals, shelters, multi-site or special-access programs	Custom Proposal

Each base portrait experience may include:

- A brief 10-15 minute professional portrait experience
- Professional image selection and retouching
- One finished digital portrait per participating child/family
- One 5x7 fine-art print when sponsorship funding permits
- Additional portraits may be offered for purchase when appropriate

HOW SPONSORSHIP WORKS

Your sponsorship funds the Portraits of Promise experience. Sponsorship dollars underwrite professional photography services provided by Uniquely June LLC for children and families served by our community partners. Program funding may cover photography, professional editing, finished portraits, and other approved program expenses.

Program fees represent professional services provided by Uniquely June LLC. They may be funded by the community partner, one or more sponsors, or a combination of both. Sponsorship of Portraits of Promise should not be represented as a tax-deductible charitable contribution to Uniquely June LLC. When a nonprofit partner is involved, any charitable contribution or tax-deductibility determination is handled by that organization under its own policies and applicable law.

DIRECT SPONSORSHIP	NONPROFIT-FUNDED PROGRAM
Sponsor funds Uniquely June LLC directly to provide a defined Portraits of Promise experience for the community partner.	Sponsor contributes to the participating nonprofit; the nonprofit separately contracts with Uniquely June LLC for the photography program.

SPONSORSHIP WITH PURPOSE

Flexible ways to fund portraits - and strengthen the community.

A sponsor may fund an entire portrait experience or join with other supporters. For example, a \$2,000 community experience could be supported by four \$500 sponsors, or by one \$1,000 presenting sponsor and two \$500 supporting sponsors.

\$250-\$500 Supporting Sponsor	\$1,000 Promise Mini Sponsor	\$1,500+ Community / Presenting Sponsor
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AN OPTIONAL COMMUNITY GIFT

Portraits of Promise does not require Uniquely June LLC to return a portion of its professional photography fee to the host organization. Instead, sponsors may choose to make an additional community gift that directly supports the participating organization's approved family needs.

\$2,250 Funds professional portrait experiences for up to 25 children/families.	\$2,750 example Funds the \$2,250 portrait experience plus a \$500 community enhancement.
Paid for professional photography services provided by Uniquely June LLC.	The additional community gift can support backpacks, school supplies, children's books, refreshments, toiletries, family-care packages, or another approved need. Ideally, this portion is paid directly to the nonprofit/community organization.

SPECIALIZED COMMUNITY SETTINGS

Hospitals, shelters, foster/adoption programs, and other specialized environments may require flexible scheduling, privacy accommodations, mobility or access considerations, infection-control requirements, or a different session flow. These programs may be quoted by half-day, full-day, or custom project fee rather than strictly per participant.

The sponsor provides the gift. Uniquely June LLC provides the professional service.

Final pricing and deliverables are confirmed in a written proposal based on location, participant count, travel, access requirements, and program needs. Community partners and sponsors should clearly understand whether funds are paying Uniquely June LLC for professional services or are being contributed separately to the participating organization.
