Saturday, December 8, 2018, at 11 AM is the DAR Wreath Laying and SAR Commemoration of the Battle of Great Bridge at Historic Battlefield & Waterways Park.

Also starting on December 8th is the 24th Annual Battle of Great Bridge Re-enactment. This two-day event is held at Battlefield Park South which is located just south of the Great Bridge Bridge. It is the original site of the battle fought December 9, 1775. Step back in time with us and experience Re-enactments of the Battle of Great Bridge. The event also highlights Revolutionary War encampments, demonstrations, character portrayals, camp life, historical displays and lectures, skilled artisans demonstrating early American trades and children's crafts and activities.
