LIFE, LIBERTY AND THE PURSUIT OF WATER

Discover reasons for the American Revolution and the role of the Virginia Colony by learning about colonial life in Virginia, the Stamp Act, Dunmore's Proclamation, and heroes of the Battle of Great Bridge. Explore the strategic importance of this location and the impact of its outcome. Learn how the waterways shaped transportation of goods, supplies and troops during colonial times. Investigate the watershed, wetlands, habitats, and ecosystems around the Great Bridge.

Programs include a guided tour through the museum, a tour of the outdoor historic trail and a walk along our nature trail and overlook. Your students will interact with experienced docents who will engage and inspire. We can accommodate groups with multiple ages and grade levels.

GROUP SIZE: We can accommodate groups up to 100 in one day. Large groups may be split to ensure all students have an enjoyable and educational visit.

LENGTH OF TIME: Program length is approximately 2.5 hours

COST: Museum and Historic Park field trip cost is \$6.00 per student. For faster check-in, one payment may be made at admissions or advanced payment may be made by calling (757) 482-4480. We accept cash, credit, and business checks made payable to GBB&WHF. Personal checks are not accepted.

CHAPERONES: One chaperone per 15 students is free. Additional chaperones are \$6.00 per person

PARKING: Parking is free and available onsite.

PICNICING: Outdoor picnic tables and grounds are available for bagged lunches. Picnic tables accommodate 60 students including four wheelchairs. Additionally, several benches are available for use during lunch.
