


# **KSSD TRUST ATTENDANCE ANALYSIS & INSIGHTS** (2024-2025)

This report provides an analysis of student attendance trends over the past year, highlighting key patterns, challenges and recommendations for continued improvement.

#### **Overview**

The student attendance data from January 2024 to January 2025 reflects a significant improvement in student engagement and participation at KSSD Trust. This positive trend is driven by enhanced teaching methods, increased parental involvement and the introduction of digital learning resources. The average attendance over this period stands at 81.91%, showcasing a steady increase in student presence throughout the year.





# **Key Observations**

- Increasing Attendance Trend: Attendance improved from 70% in January 2024 to 95% in January 2025, indicating growing student commitment and interest. The high attendance in February and March 2024 can be attributed to the annual exams conducted in March, which encouraged consistent student participation during this period.
- Mid-Year Fluctuations (April-June 2024): A notable drop in attendance (70%-75%) was observed during this period, potentially due to seasonal challenges, farming work, or external academic pressures.
- ✓ Strong Second-Half Performance: The launch of Feeding India's Daily Meal Program in July 2024 contributed to consistent attendance. From July to December 2024, attendance remained consistently high (above 82%), suggesting improved engagement, better resources and community support.
- Record-High Attendance in January 2025: At 95%, this marks the highest recorded attendance, potentially driven by the anticipation of new educational facilities (such as the STEAM lab) and increased student motivation.

## Recommendations

- Sustain Engagement Strategies: Continue with interactive teaching, incentives and parental involvement. The implementation of gamified learning modules and project-based activities has significantly increased student participation and enthusiasm.
- Address Seasonal Declines: Introduce engaging summer programs or flexible attendance policies during April-June to mitigate attendance drops.
- Leverage High Momentum: Utilize the current enthusiasm to introduce new learning methods and digital education programs that align with student interests.
