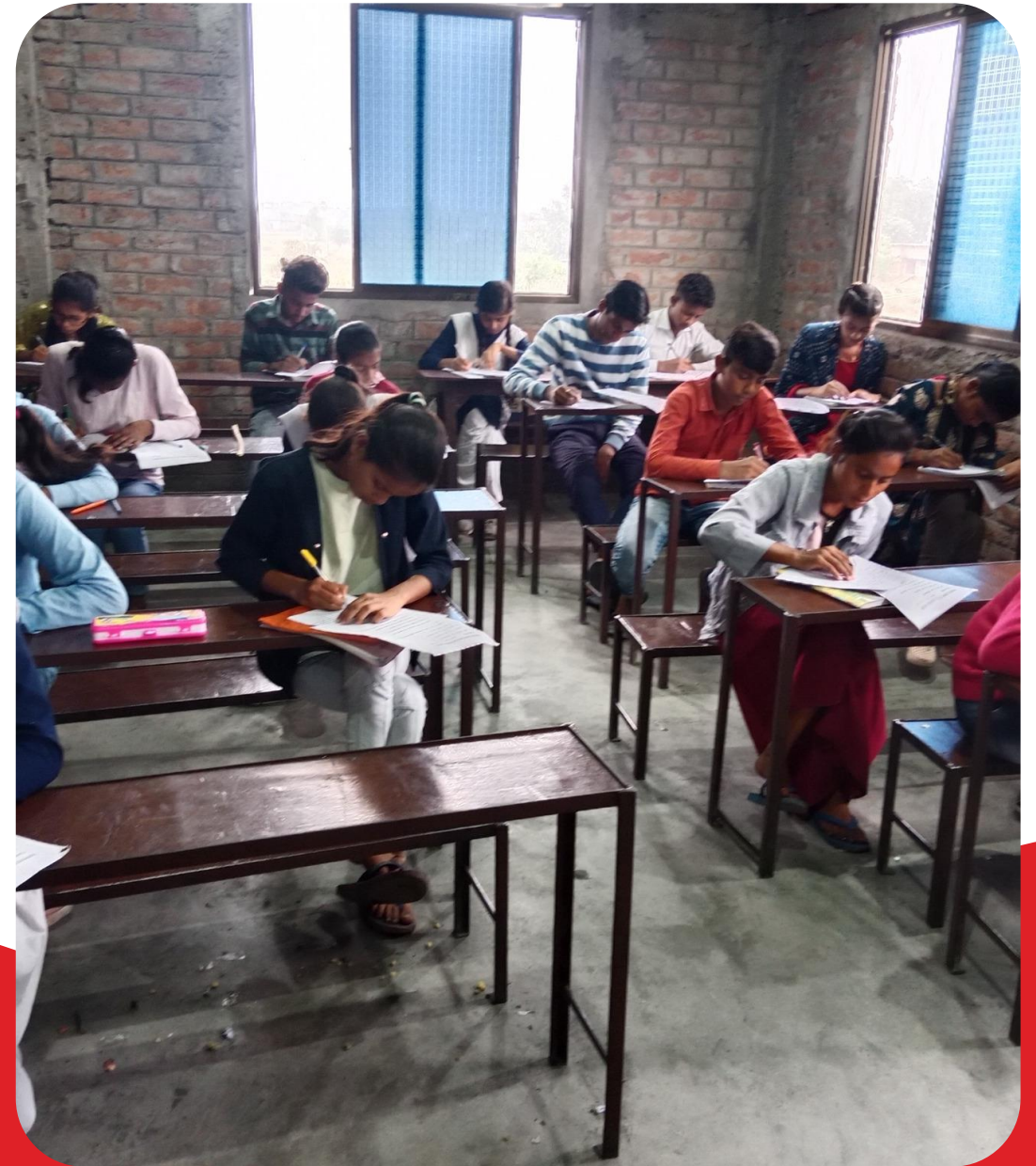


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KSSD Trust Introduction

The KSSD Public Charitable & Welfare Trust, established in 2022, is a nonprofit organization dedicated to empowering underprivileged children through comprehensive quality education and healthcare. Inspired by the story of a remarkable girl who nearly discontinued her education due to lack of family support, the Trust is committed to enhancing education, skill training, health, digital literacy, teacher training, career guidance & mentoring, and special support for girls' education ensuring they can lead independent and dignified lives.

Since its inception, KSSD Trust has empowered over 1200 underprivileged children through these initiatives. Kanhaiya Singh Shikshan Kendra (KSSK) and Sugeshwari Devi Evening School provide education up to class 10th, focusing on digital skill-building, teacher training, scholarships, career guidance, and mentoring. Special support for female students is a priority, complemented by comprehensive health checkups and stringent hygiene and safety standards. Our mission is to create a nurturing environment that ensures holistic development and equitable opportunities for all children.

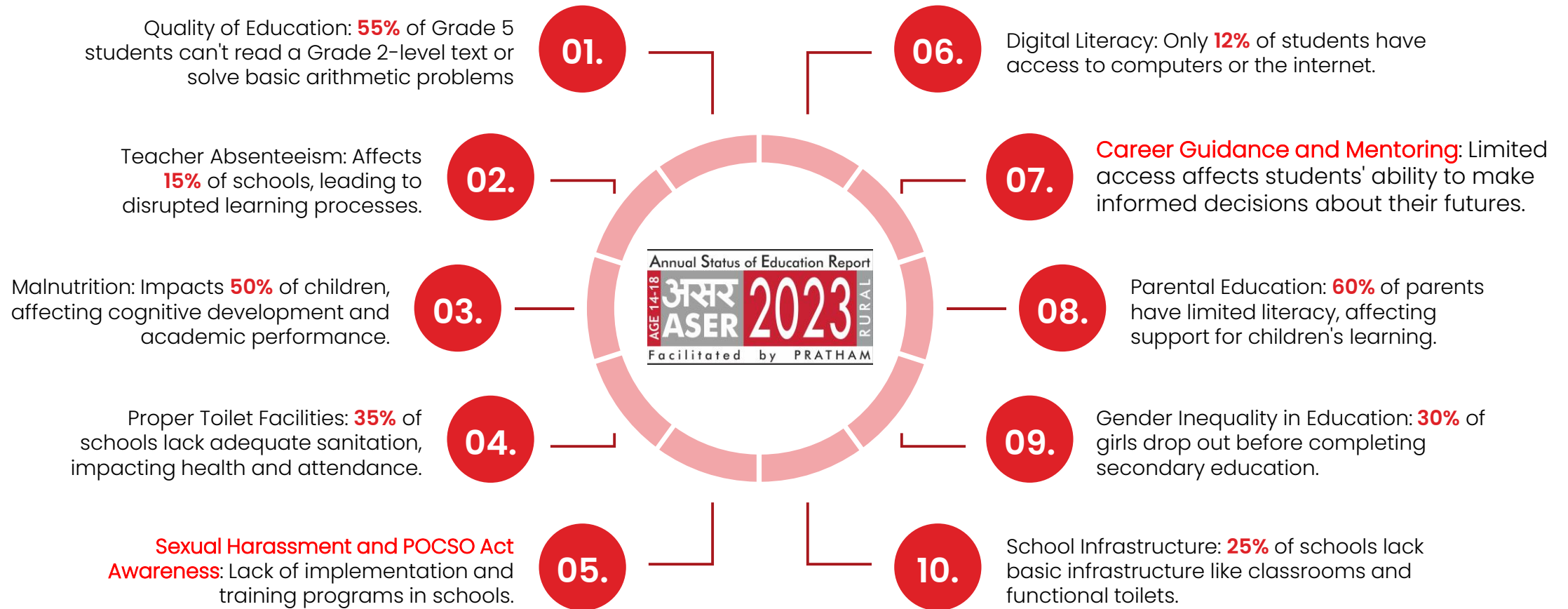

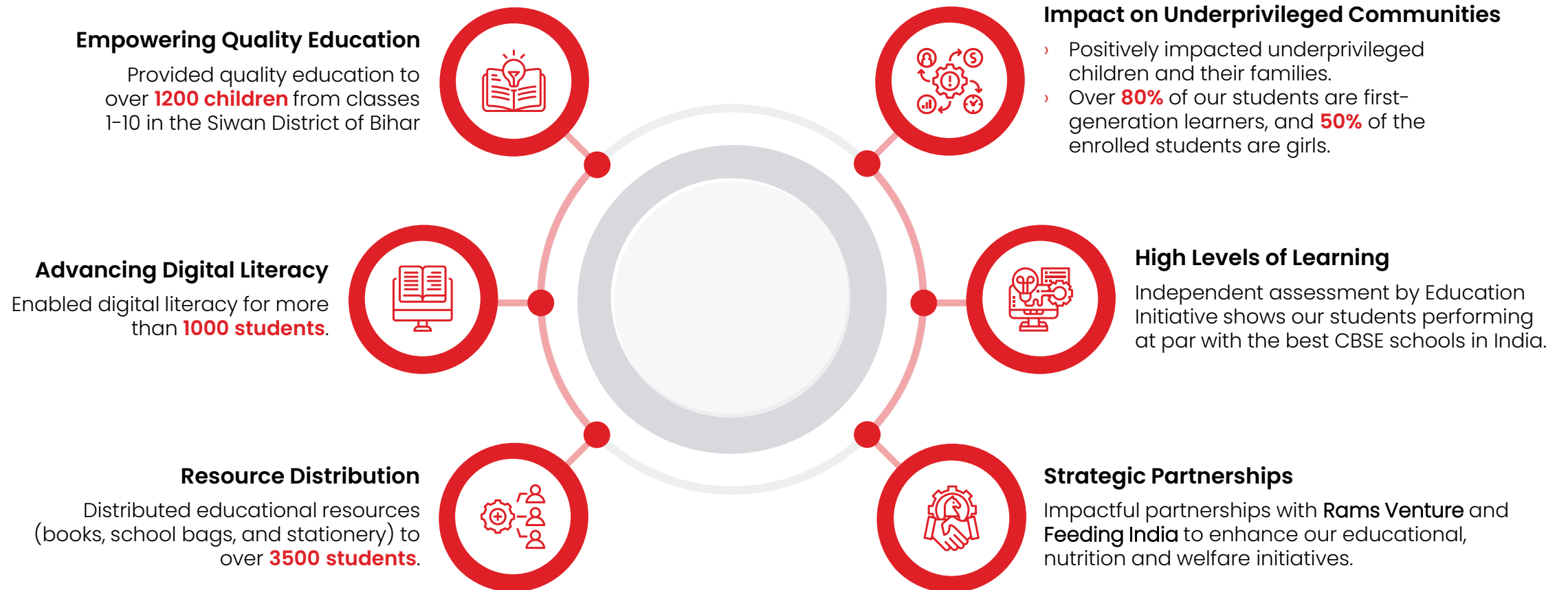
