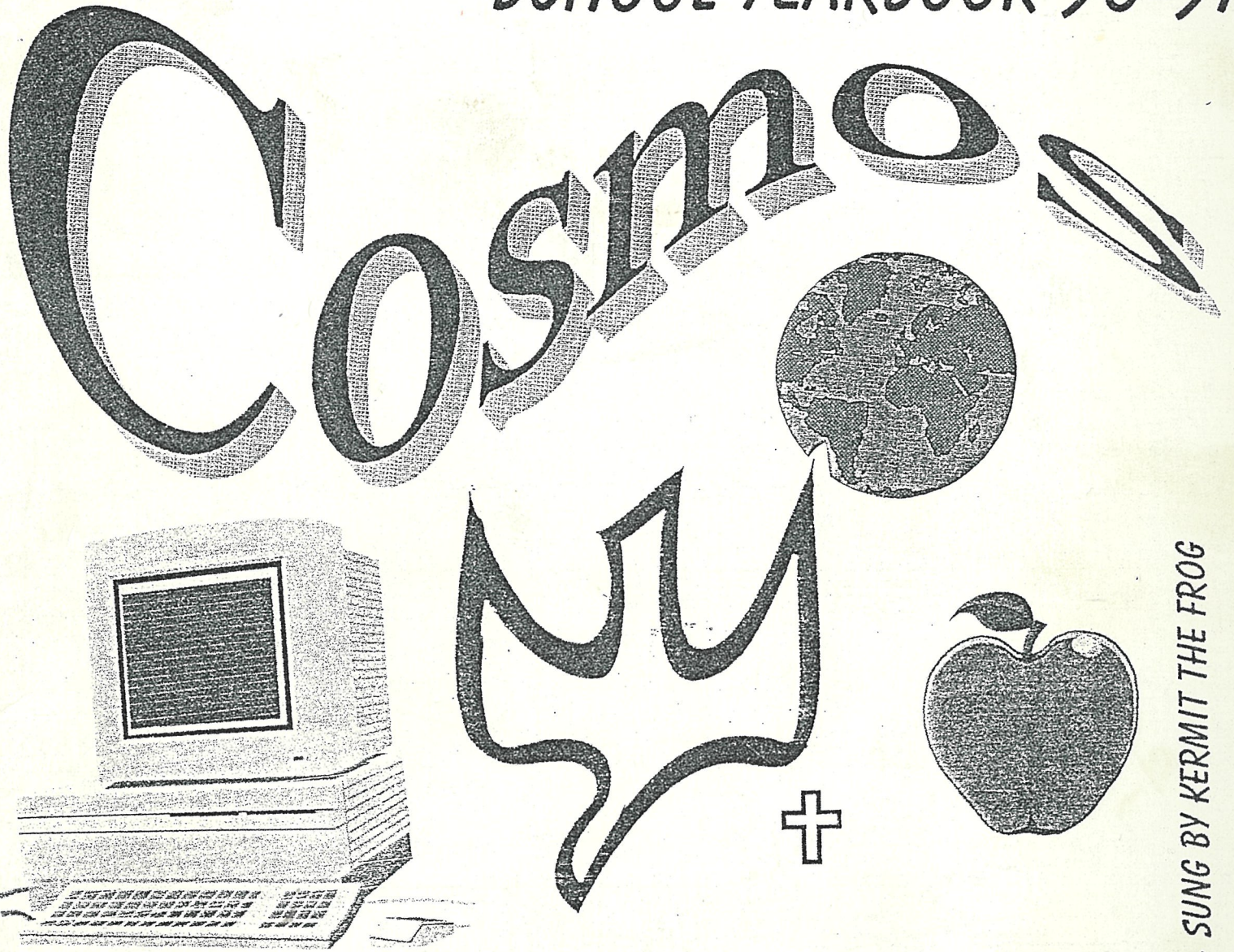

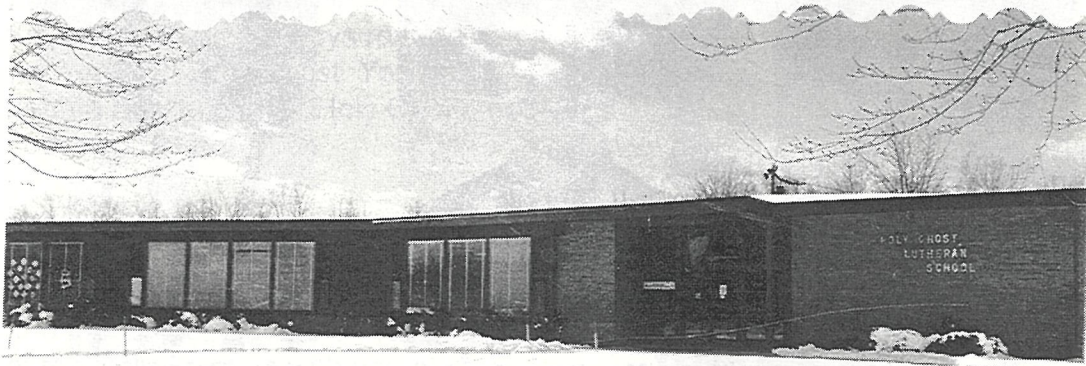

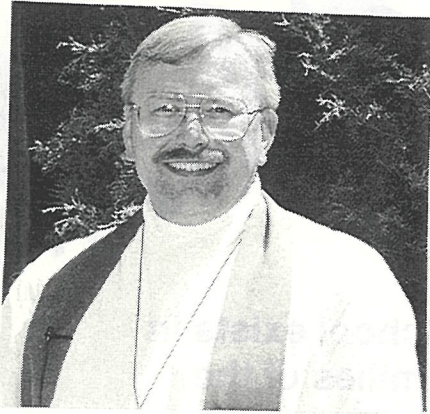
Our Mission Statement

- providing services for building and strengthening Christian morals and values in their homes



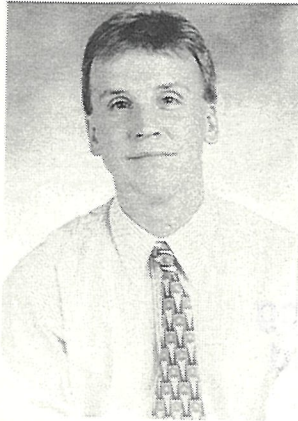

DEDICATION



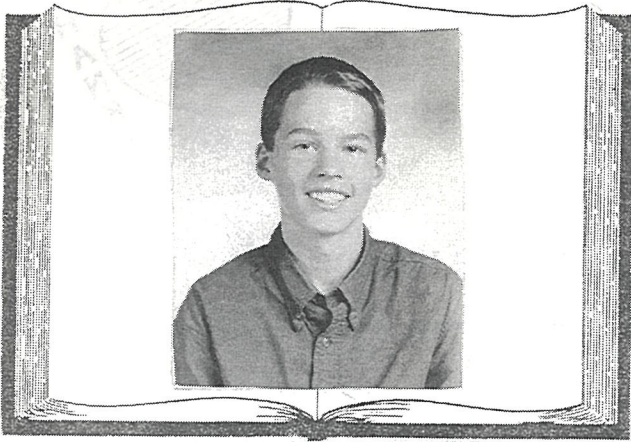
We the 7th & 8th grade classes, would like to dedicate this yearbook to all of our wonderful teachers from Kindergarten to 8th Grade.

Most Likely To Succeed : Lynette Klettke

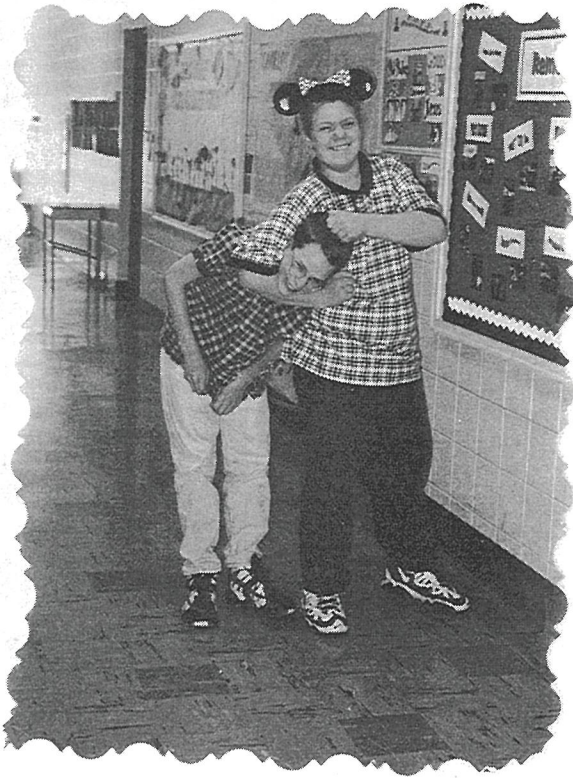

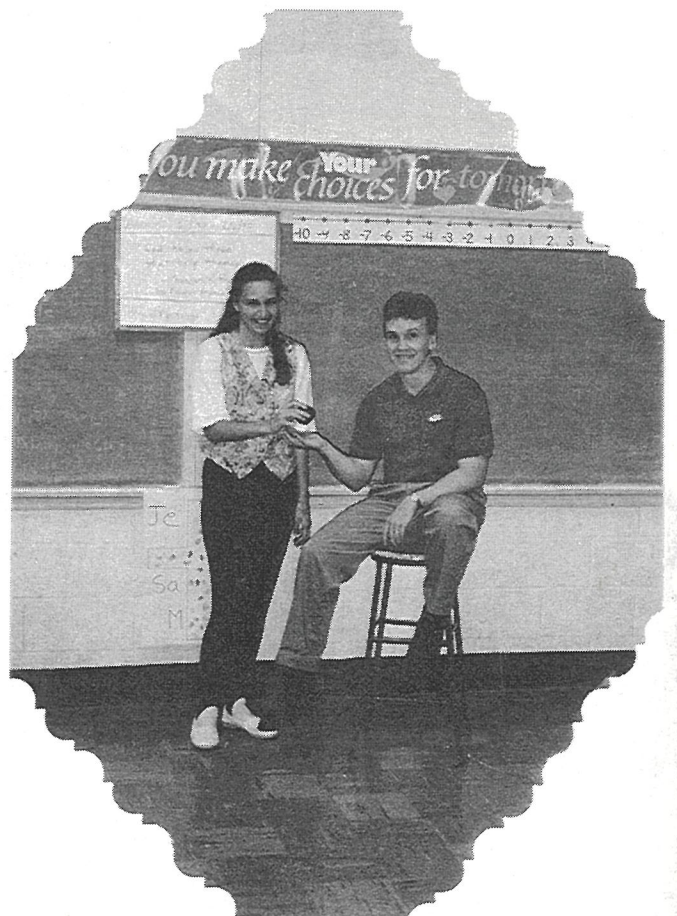


Class Clown : Bobby Gurley

Most School Spirit: Megan Ciszek

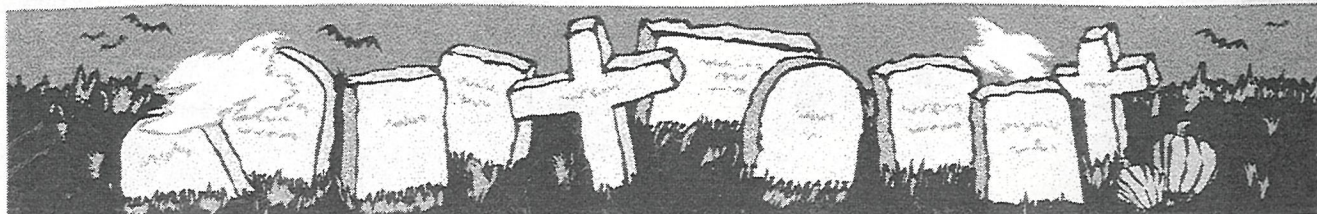
