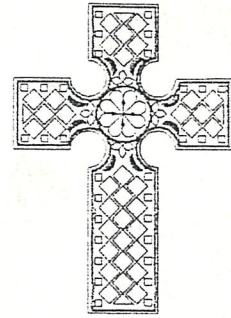

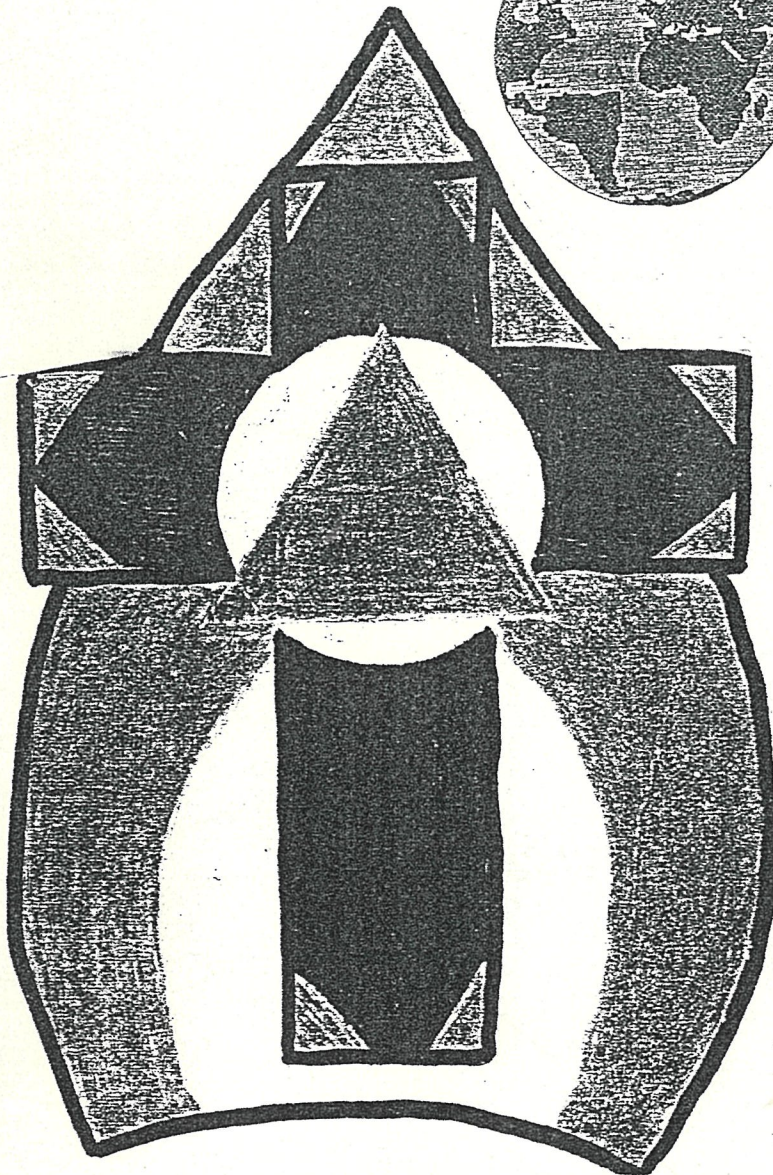

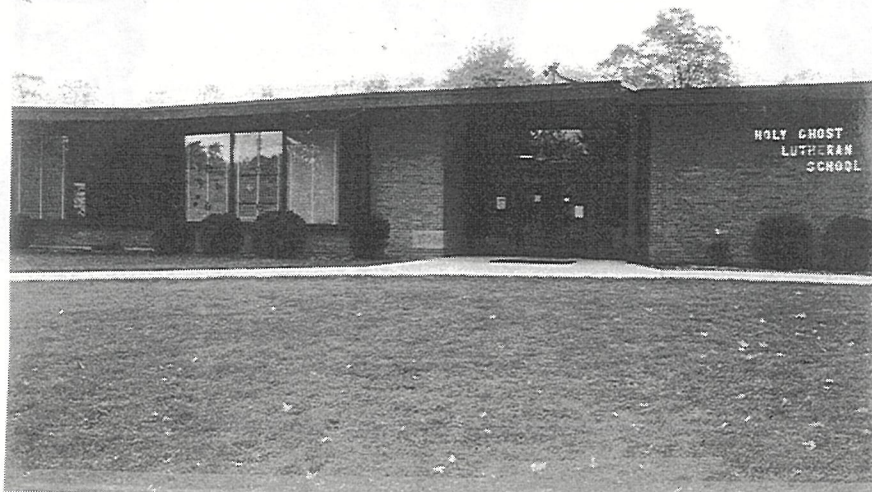
OUR MISSION STATEMENT

Most School Spirit: Amy Masterman

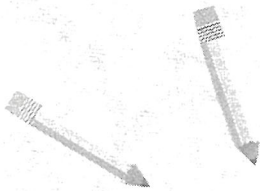

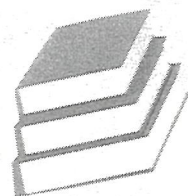
Best Dressed: Paul Carella

Best Athlete: Jon Snell

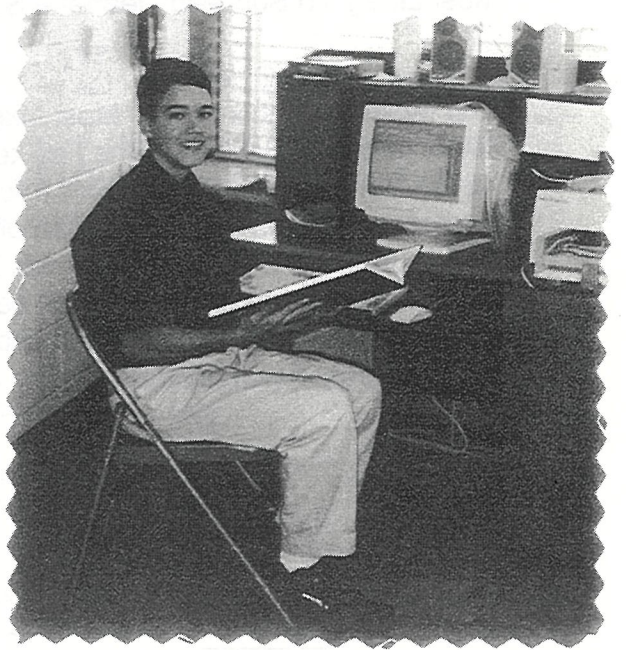
