# FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

The seasons are changing and our golf season is ending...where has the time gone?! Actually, where have the last two years gone?

Looking back— In November of 2021, the Invited corporate offices (previously known as Clubcorp) announced a major plan to reorganize the golf properties in The Woodlands/Magnolia areas. As a result of this re-organization, Lake Windcrest became an independent entity with independent memberships rather than being one of three properties under the same membership.

That event created a void in league golf for the women who opted to choose Lake Windcrest as their primary membership...but, not for long. By January of 2022, a Board consisting of volunteers, developed the required By-Laws necessary to formulate the organization and establish a bank account.

Then, with the full support of our GM, Troy Muller, we established three playdays (a very generous accommodation by our managemen

since many clubs around us have more limited opportunities), increased our membership by almost double, hosted two successful invitational tournaments and took a 1st place net prize in Ladies Challenge Cup competition!

Now, two years later, we close chapter 1 of the LW WGA story and move on to the next 2 year chapter. This month you will be asked to elect a new Board to provide the leadership for a firmly established Women' Golf Association. A ballot will be provided to you via email before the 15th of the month. The offices to be filled are President. Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Tournament Co-Chairs.

Our By-Laws call for an Executive Board consisting of 7 members, the above 6 and an Immediate Past-President. Until now, we have not existed long enough to have that position filled, but I will serve in that capacity for the next term. The obvious rationale is to provide continuity from a retiring Board to new Board. However, we are fortunate to have some currently serving Board members willing to continue to serve which also brings continuity. Please return your

ballot to me via email by Sunday, November 26th...your participation in the election is most important. In addition to the ballot, you will find a questionnaire which seeks your input about games and events for the 2024 season...again, your responses are most important.

As our season draws to a close, we will celebrate with an end of year luncheon and awards presentation. A golf event will precede the luncheon, usually involving a nominal cash entry fee with a cash payout. All members are the guests of the WGA for lunch. We have many ladies who support our organization but may not be very active

glfers...this invitation includes ALL members! We ask that you indicate in the comments section at SignUp.com if you are attending just the luncheon, otherwise, your sign up will be interpreted as signing up for both golf and lunch.
